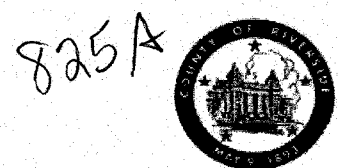

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

By Minute Order dated April 8, 2014 (Agenda Item 3-27), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Columbia Street Sidewalk Safety Project, Acacia Avenue to Tava Lane in the community of East Hemet.

Six bids were received on April 30, 2014, ranging from \$208,272 to \$278,750. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Carvajal Trucking & Tractor, Inc. (CT&T) in the amount of \$208,272, which is \$21,728 (9.45%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The construction duration set for this project is approximately two months, and construction is anticipated to be completed during summer of 2014.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the Contract, and has provided bonds, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The proposed improvements will improve safety for pedestrians and motorists and will provide an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant path.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The Contract is recommended to be awarded to CT&T for the total amount of \$208,272. The project is funded with Gas Tax (ABX8-9 Mar 2010 New HUTA) and SB 821 Local Transportation funds, for which the County successfully competed and obtained. There are no General Funds used for this project.

The project is expected to finish within the existing budget as shown on Attachment A.

## Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **Carvajal Trucking & Tractor, Inc.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

### WITNESSETH

#### Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Columbia Street Sidewalk Safety Project, Acacia Avenue to Tava Lane, East Hemet Community, Project No. C4-0048**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

#### Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

##### 1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice Inviting Bids, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda none, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work, (o) Any Change Orders issued, (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

## 2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

## 3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07 "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.03, "Beginning of Work" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

## 4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

## **BOARD RULES**

### **Requests to Address Board on "Agenda" Items:**

You may request to be heard on a published agenda item. Requests to be heard must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board before the scheduled meeting time.

### **Requests to Address Board on items that are "NOT" on the Agenda:**

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these rules, member of the public shall have the right to address the Board during the mid-morning "Oral Communications" segment of the published agenda. Said purpose for address must pertain to issues which are under the direct jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors. YOUR TIME WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES.

### **Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:**

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, insuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please insure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo.

### **Individual Speaker Limits:**

**Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes.** Please step up to the podium when the Chairman calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. The Chairman adheres to a strict three (3) minutes per speaker. ***Note: If you intend to give your time to a "Group/Organized Presentation", please state so clearly at the very bottom of the reverse side of this form.***

### **Group/Organized Presentations:**

Group/organized presentations with more than one (1) speaker will be limited to nine (9) minutes at the Chairman's discretion. The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the front bottom of the form.

### **Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chairman:**

The Chairman will determine what order the speakers will address the Board, and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles in order to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the general public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chairman may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.
