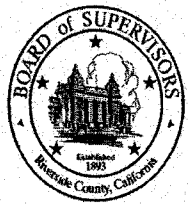

## **BACKGROUND: CONTINUED**

- 1. Single Mothers United in Fellowship, SMURF- \$3,600-** provides \$25 gas cards to mothers who are in financial stress and need to get to work, get their children to the doctors, or do job searching.
- 2. Anza Community Hall - \$8,500-** working in partnership with the Anza Community Hall and the Anza Municipal Advisory Council will build the second Welcome to Anza Monument to assist in promoting economic development for the Anza Valley. Community participation and involvement and several volunteers will donate their time, treasury and tradesmanship including construction, electrical and survey services. Additionally, the land for the monument has been donated by Anza residents.
- 3. Winchester Town Association- \$10,000-** in partnership with the Winchester/ Homeland Municipal Advisory Council the funding will be used for exploratory study on the feasibility and implementation strategies for the Downtown Winchester Conceptual plan.
- 4. Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee- \$500-** for the Law Enforcement Appreciation Dinner to recognize and honor police officers for distinguished police work and outstanding service.
- 5. Temecula Valley Rose Society- \$2,000-** to provide stairs and handrails in steep areas of the garden where slipping is a hazard.
