BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Mission Trail branch library opened in 2001, prior to the incorporation of the City of Wildomar in 2008. In the summer of 2013, the community room was expanded, and the entire branch received a facelift. The library is active and has been embraced by the City of Wildomar with 152,401 visits and 73,961 items checked out in 2013/2014.

Renaming the library "Wildomar Library" will reflect more accurately the library's identity and provide the residents a public anchor in the City.

Supervisor Jeffries supports the request by the City of Wildomar and the Friends of the Mission Trail Community Library to officially re-name the library as the "Wildomar Library.

Any minor costs associated with the re-naming will be borne by the City or by the Friends of the Mission Trail Community Library.
