BACKGROUND:

Summary (Continued)

The Community Foundation serving the Counties of Riverside and San Bernardino Counties created and produced the past Riverside County Community Indicators Reports. The report presents research and analysis that reflects key indicators of our county's economic, social and environmental wellbeing.

The Community Indicators Report provides a valuable tool to evaluate, target and address important issues annually.

One sample indicator will look at employment and salaries in five industry clusters chosen to reflect the diversity of Riverside County employment, major economic drivers within the county, and important industry sectors for workforce development. Approximately 41% of all Riverside County jobs can be found in the five clusters described in this indicator

The report offers an honest and objective self-assessment of the county. The Community Foundation has the ability and resources to create and produce this report for 2014. The Community Indicators Report has a total sponsored cost of \$50,000. Provided the Board approves the attached sole source procurement request, Economic Development Agency (EDA) will initially cover the full amount of \$50,000. Pending commitment from other county departments' sponsorships, EDA will be partially reimbursed, depending on the other county department contributions. Last year, county departments sponsored \$11,500 for the 2013 Community Indicators Report; EDA paid for the balance of \$38,500. If approved, EDA will solicit sponsorships from county departments for the 2014 report.

Many reports are regional and give information on San Bernardino County and Riverside County only as a collective region. This report is customized, tailored to Riverside County and provides specific data that applies only to our County. The Community Foundation is the only entity that produces this particular report. The report reflects an on-going commitment to promote advocacy for our region's key needs and issues that will build stronger collaborations to address these needs.

Upon approval of the attached sole source procurement request, a professional services agreement (or an equivalent agreement) will be negotiated and prepared by the County and The Community Foundation, which shall be approved as to form by County Counsel. The agreement shall contain, at a minimum, the following terms and provisions:

- Terms consistent with the Board of Supervisor's approved sole source procurement request, including, but not limited to a contract price of \$50,000, all inclusive; and
- Standard County contract terms and provisions.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the attached document. Staff recommends approval of the attached document.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Community Indicators Report will give community leaders another tool to help address and resolve important issues affecting residents and businesses.
