SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBLEASE

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBLEASE ("Second Amendment"), dated as of ________, 2014, is entered into by and between the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a political subdivision of the State of California, County, and PALO VERDE HEALTH CARE DISTRICT, Sublessee.

RECITALS

- a. County and Sublessee have entered into that certain Sublease dated January 6, 1998 (the "Sublease") pursuant to which County has agreed to Sublease to Sublessee and Sublessee has agreed to Sublease from County that certain building located at 205 North First Street, Blythe, as more particularly described in the Sublease.
 - b. The amendments of the Sublease are summarized as follows:
- 1. The First Amendment to Sublease dated September 30, 2008 by and between The County of Riverside, and Palo Verde Health Care District.
 - c. The Parties now desire to amend the Sublease to extend the term.
- 1. NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:
- 2. RENT. Section 6 of the Sublease is amended as follows: The monthly rent during the extended term shall be as follows:

September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014 - \$17,531.84

September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015 - \$18,057.79

September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016 - \$18,599.52

September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017 - \$19,157.50

September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018 - \$19,732.22

3. TERM. Section 4 of the Sublease shall be amended as follows: The term of this Sublease shall be extended an additional five (5) years commencing on September 1, 2013 and terminating on August 31, 2018.

- 5. SECOND AMENDMENT TO PREVAIL. The provisions of this Second Amendment shall prevail over any inconsistency or conflicting provisions of the Sublease. Any capitalized terms shall have the meaning defined in the Sublease, unless defined herein or context requires otherwise.
- 6. MISCELLANEOUS. Except as amended or modified herein, all terms of the Sublease shall remain in full force and effect. If any provisions of this Amendment shall be determined to be illegal or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect any other provision of the Sublease. Neither this Amendment nor the Sublease shall be recorded by the County.
