RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and authorize the Board to execute the Second Amendment to the agreement with Faculty Physicians and Surgeons of Loma Linda School of Medicine effective July 1, 2014 for an aggregate amount not to exceed \$2,410,000 annually.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Faculty Physicians and Surgeons (FP&S) of the Loma Linda School of Medicine provide a full range of General Pediatric, Pediatric Intensivists, Neonatology and Pediatric Specialty Care Physicians required to meet the numerous requirements of the Hospital's California Children's Services (CCS) designation for the Pediatric Departments at the hospital as well as the requirements for Pediatric Trauma designation.

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) is the only hospital within the County of Riverside to provide a Pediatric Intensive Care Unit as part of the hospital's trauma program. Currently, the specialties provided by Faculty Physicians and Surgeons of Loma Linda School of Medicine (FP&S) include Board Certified Pediatric Intensive Care, Neonatology, General Pediatrics, Neurology, Gastroenterology, Endocrinology, High Risk Development, Cardiology, Infectious Disease, Nephrology, Hematology / Oncology, Pulmonology, Allergy / Immunology, and Nephrology physicians.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

This service impacts the patients receiving care from Riverside County Regional Medical Center. The benefits of this amendment offer a visibility of the hospital's PICU within the community.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On May 25, 2010, agenda item number 3.46, the Board approved the Professional Contract Agreement with Faculty Physicians and Surgeons of Loma Linda University School of Medicine to provide a full range of pediatric and specialty care services to meet the requirements of the Hospital's California Children's Services (CCS) designation. On November 6, 2012; agenda item number 3.56, the Board approved the amendment to add professional services for the development of ambulatory service initiatives for the Riverside County Health System.

This amendment will allow the contract between RCRMC and FP&S to include Directorship for Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) to conduct outreach to surrounding hospitals and clinician's, provide education for the hospital nursing staff along with the hospitals residency programs and assist in the development of a sedation service for pediatric patients.

SECOND AMENDMENT

TO THE

PROFESSIONAL MEDICAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

AND

FACULTY PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS OF LOMA LINDA SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

That certain Agreement between the County of Riverside (COUNTY) on behalf of the Riverside County Regional Medical Center (HOSPITAL) and Faculty Physicians and Surgeons of Loma Linda University School of Medicine (CONTRACTOR) dated October 1, 2010, amended effective August 1, 2012 is hereby further amended effective July 1, 2014, pursuant to the following:

- 1. Add Exhibit E, Pediatric Intensive Care (PICU) Directorship services, attached hereto as Attachment II to this Agreement.
- 2. Delete Exhibit A, Section 3.0 and replace with the following:

"Maximum annual compensation payable under this Agreement shall not exceed two million, four hundred ten thousand (\$2,410,000) dollars."

All other terms and conditions of this Agreement are to remain unchanged.

EXHIBIT E TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

FACULTY PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS OF LLUSM (CONTRACTOR)

PEDIATRIC INTENSIVE CARE (PICU) DIRECTORSHIP SERVICES

SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONTRACTOR agrees to provide a PICU medical director for the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit at the Hospital to provide outreach to surrounding hospitals and clinicians and increase the visibility of Hospital's PICU's in the community. The PICU medical director will provide education for the Hospital nursing staff along with the HOSPITAL residency programs. The PICU medical director at the request of Hospital Administration and in coordination with the anesthesia medical group, shall assist in the development of a sedation service to provide sedation services for the HOSPITAL's pediatric patients. The PICU medical director will assist in the development of a process between Loma Linda and the Hospital for the PICU transport team to bring patients to the HOSPITAL.

2. STAFFING

CONTRACTOR agrees to provide the services of a pediatric critical care intensivist to serve as Medical Director for the HOSPTIAL'S Pediatric Intensive Care Unit.

3. COMPENSATION

Subject to the conditions set forth above, HOSPITAL shall pay CONTRACTOR a total of one hundred fifty thousand (\$150,000) dollars per year for the services described herein which approximates a .50 FTE.

4. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate the PICU directorship services as set forth in this exhibit by giving one hundred twenty (120) days written notice to the other Party hereto. In the event of said termination of services under this Exhibit, the remaining provisions of the agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
