BACKGROUND: (cont.)

On April 1, 2014, the Department introduced Ordinance 779.15 which included a recommendation to increase the minimum load (0.4 tons or less) charge from a flat fee of \$8.00 to \$9.00 per load. This proposed rate represents a 38% discount compared to a load weighing 0.4 tons pro-rated at \$36.21 per ton. It was further recommended that loads containing more than 50% yard or wood waste be increased from a flat fee of \$11.00 to \$12.00. This proposed rate represents a 35% discount compared to a load containing 50% or more wood or yard waste weighing 0.4 tons pro-rated at \$46.21 per ton. The Board approved the Department's recommendation and the Ordinance was set for public hearing and adopted on May 6, 2014. Subsequently, the Department recognized errors in the minimum load rates as reflected on Appendix A of Ordinance 779.15, which misstate the minimum load rate for routine refuse as \$10.00 per load and the minimum load rate for loads containing more than 50% yard or wood waste as \$13.00. To correct these errors, the Department submits a revised (redlined) version of Appendix A for Board approval.

In consultation with County Counsel, it has been determined that correction of this simple clerical error may be done by Form 11 only, and that no other action is required (Government Code Section 36934).

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The correction to Ordinance 779.15 will not result in any impact to Citizens or Businesses.
