- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to deliver the Notice of Exemption to the Office of the County Clerk for filing within five (5) working days of this Board hearing.

### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

As a Condition of Approval for Tract Map 29597 and Tract Map 29741, Pigeon Pass Road is being realigned. The new road alignment will be dedicated on said Tract Maps. As a result of this realignment, portions of Pigeon Pass Road are no longer necessary, and the applicant has requested the vacation of these portions of Pigeon Pass Road. As a result of this realignment, portions of Pigeon Pass Road are no longer necessary and the applicant has requested the vacation of portions of Pigeon Pass Road (See attached Exhibit's "A" and "B").

This vacation will not eliminate access to any parcel. The Riverside County Transportation Department, Riverside County Flood Control Department and the Riverside County Fire Department have reviewed this vacation and have no objections.

In accordance with Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered a covered activity. Therefore, no mitigation is required for the proposed improvements of this project.

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposals qualify for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines and the Riverside County Rules to Implement CEQA.

# SUMMARILY VACATING PORTIONS OF PIGEON PASS ROAD IN THE HIGHGROVE AREA

(Second Supervisorial District)

WHEREAS, the hereinafter-described portions of Pigeon Pass Road lying easterly of the easterly Right-of-Way as described by Document, recorded December 20, 1932, in Book 97, Pages 231 through 233, inclusive, Official Records of Riverside County, California, and north of the south line of Section 10 Township 2 South, Range 4 West, was dedicated and accepted for public use per the following as shown on Deed Plat 702-V on file with the Riverside County Surveyors Office, Riverside California, together with Parcel 7192-003 as conveyed to the County of Riverside by document recorded February 23, 1989, as Instrument No. 56381, and document recorded March 22, 1989, as Instrument No. 88503, both Official Records of said Riverside County, as shown on Rightof-Way Map 878-T on file with the Riverside County Surveyors Office, Riverside, California, together with Parcels 7192-004, 792-007, 7192-008, 7192-009, 7192-010, 7192-013, 7192-015, 7192-016, 7192-020 and 7192-021 as conveyed to the County of Riverside by document recorded February 28,1989, as instrument No.'s 060925, 060926, 060927, 060928, 060929, 060930 and 060931, and re-recorded January 30, 1992, as Instrument no. 033406, all Official Records of said Riverside County, as shown on said Right-of-Way Map 878-T, together with Parcels 7192-005, and 7192-006, as conveyed to the County of Riverside by document recorded February 22, 1989, as Instrument No 053995, Official Records of said Riverside County, as shown on said Right-of-Way Map 878-T, together with Parcels 7192-011, 7192-012, 7192-014 and 7192-019, as conveyed to the County of Riverside by document recorded on June 13, 1989, as Instrument No.'s 194186, 194187 and 194188, all Official Records of said Riverside County, as shown on

said Right-of-Way Map 878-T, together with Parcels 7192-017 and 7192-018, as conveyed to the County of Riverside by document recorded April 19, 1989, as Instrument No. 123699, Official Records of said Riverside County, as shown on said Right-of-Way map 878-T; and

WHEREAS, the hereinafter-described portions of Pigeon Pass Road are not necessary and are excess, and not required for public street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, applicable procedures pertaining to summary vacations were followed pursuant to the County's adopted "Resolutions for Fixing Procedures to Vacate and Accept County Highways and Property Offered for Dedication"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on <a href="September 9">September 9</a>, 2014, as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 8334(a) of the Streets and Highways Code that the herein described portions of Pigeon Pass Road were dedicated and accepted for public use are excess and are no longer required for public street and highway purposes and are hereby summarily vacated.
- 2. That the herein-described portions of Pigeon Pass Road are unnecessary for present or prospective public use, including use as a non-motorized transportation facility.

SEE LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND PLAT ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBITS "A" AND "B" AND MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING from the vacation an easement for any existing public utilities and public service facilities, together with the right to maintain, operate, replace, remove, or renew such facilities, pursuant to section 8340 of the Streets and Highways Code.




















### **EXHIBIT** VACATION OF A PORTION OF PIGEON PASS ROAD
