

NORTH NORCO CHANNEL STAGE 10 PROJECT NO. 2-0-00140



The proposed project is located just upstream of River Road within the city of Norco in Riverside County, California. The District's North Norco Channel is improved to its ultimate capacity upstream and downstream of this proposed improvement except for some 650+ feet of interim channel just upstream of River Road. This project, which consists of approximately 550 lineal feet of triple cell reinforced concrete box (RCB) and 125 lineal feet of open concrete channel transition, will replace the existing interim dirt channel and will bring this segment of North Norco Channel to its ultimate capacity. Once this segment is constructed, North Norco Channel, a backbone drainage facility in the City of Norco, will have ultimate capacity from its outlet near Prado Dam inundation area to upstream of 1—15.
