- 1. Find that the vacation of a portion of Suttles Drive is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Sections 15301 and 15061 (b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines; and
- 2. Adopt Resolution No. 2014-058, Summarily Vacating a Portion of Suttles Drive in the Woodcrest Area; and
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to deliver the Notice of Exemption to the Office of the County Clerk for filing within five (5) working days of this Board hearing.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

### <u>Summary</u>

This portion of Suttles Drive was dedicated to create a modified cul-de-sac bulb by instrument recorded October 18, 2006, as Document No. 2006-0766847, Official Records of Riverside County, California. Tract No. 27887 has dedicated a 30' half-width extending Suttles Drive southerly to Mariposa Avenue, and the applicant for Tract No. 30238 was conditioned to dedicate an additional 15.00 foot part width and provide road improvements. The dedication has been completed and recorded April 7, 2014,



BEING A PORTION OF THAT EASEMENT GRANTED TO THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE BY DOCUMENT RECORDED OCTOBER 18, 2006, AS DOCUMENT NO. 2006-0766847, OFFICIAL RECORDS OF THE RECORDER OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA LYING WITHIN THE SOUTHEAST ONE-QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST ONE-QUARTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, SAN BERNARDINO MERIDIAN, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

**COMMENCING** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID DOCUMENT NO. 2006-0766847, ALSO BEING A POINT ON THE WESTERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF SUTTLES DRIVE;

THENCE NORTH 00°15'24" EAST ALONG THE WESTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF SUTTLES DRIVE, A DISTANCE OF 32.87 FEET TO A POINT ON A NON-TANGENT CURVE, CONCAVE EASTERLY, HAVING A RADIUS OF 38.00 FEET, A RADIAL BEARING TO SAID POINT BEARS SOUTH 64°19'43" WEST, ALSO BEING THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;





**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to vacate a portion of Suttles Drive in the Woodcrest area. This portion of Suttles Drive was dedicated to create a modified cul-de-sac bulb by instrument recorded October 18, 2006 as Document No. 2006-0766847, Official Records of Riverside County, California. Tract No. 27787 has dedicated a 30' half width extending Suttles Drive southerly to Mariposa Avenue, and the applicant for Tract No. 30238 was conditioned to dedicate an additional 15.00 foot part width and provide road improvements. The dedication has been completed and recorded April 7, 2014 as Document No. 2014-0125597, Official Records of Riverside County, California, making this portion of modified cul-de-sac bulb unnecessary.

In accordance with Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered a covered activity. Therefore, no mitigation is required for the proposed improvements of this project.
