## BACKGROUND: Summary (continued)

The Department has had an Agreement with the District to perform CAP surveys in order to meet the requirement for the NPDES Permit.

The CAP includes education and outreach activities to commercial/industrial businesses by providing information on; stormwater best management practices, permitting requirements, and prohibitions against non-stormwater discharges.

Feedback is also provided regarding the compliance status of commercial/industrial facilities to the municipal stormwater permittees through the District.

These activities are conducted in conjunction with routine inspections performed by the Department's Hazardous Materials Program and District Environmental Services Program. The Department has been conducting these surveys since 2004 in Agreement with the District (Item No. 11.2)

There were additional inspections and tasks that resulted in the net cost exceeding the contract limit for Fiscal year 13/14 by \$35,000. Department staff is recommending that the Board approve the \$35,000 to allow Flood Control to reimburse the Department for the additional cost.

County Counsel has approved this Amendment as to legal form. A companion item appears on the County's Board Agenda this same date from Flood Control.

### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The regulatory requirements imposed on businesses and local government by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and Sate of California through the NPDES stormwater program continues to escalate. This Agreement allows the District to implement a compliance program through coordination with the Department.

# **Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

The original contract amount for the Agreement, the cost of this Amendment No. 2 and prior Amendment No. 1 are summarized below:

1. Contract Agreement for Support for Regional NPDES Program Activities

Original budget:

\$3,450,000 (Not to exceed \$575,000 for FY 2003/04 through FY 2008/09

Amendment No. 1:

\$1,375,000 (Reduced from Not to exceed \$575,000 to \$275,000 for FY

2009/10 through FY 2013/14, amends the scope of services

And extends the Agreement for another 5 years)

Amendment No. 2:

\$ 35,000 (An additional \$35,000 for FY 2013/14)

Total costs:

\$4,860,000
