

## **BACKGROUND: CONTINUED:**

1. **Field of Honor- \$5,000** The project benefits nearly every element of the community that participates or visits the Field of Honor. From senior citizens through grade school children, 1700 5<sup>th</sup> graders visit the Field and learn about America's history, the flag and the military service of our country. Most importantly, the Field of Honor provides an experience and message of respect and appreciation to all those that have served and continue to serve their families, their communities and their country and to ensure that people know they are appreciated and that we will never forget their contributions, dedication and commitment.
2. **Boy Scouts of America- \$7,000** to support overall Scouting programs serving families in Southwest Riverside County. The funds will be utilized to provide support for families in need through community service projects and scholarships for Boy Scout camp.
3. **Temecula Valley Balloon & Wine Festival- \$10,000** The quality 3 day event is family oriented and attended by 38, 000 people. The Festival is dedicated to enhancing the economic viability of the community through the exceptional entertainment value. Throughout this unique venue, the festival provides a showcase for inland Empire businesses for the entire year.
4. **Safe Alternatives for Everyone- \$10,000** For the Family Support Program is to intervene and prevent domestic violence in families. The services are: Emergency services, temporary restraining orders, court assistance, financial assistance, basic needs, safety planning, resource and referral and case management.
5. **Smiles for Seniors-\$1,000** This program provides senior assistance in Riverside County by providing emergency assistance for food, housing, utility payments such as water, gas, electricity, minor home repair, auto repair and lifesaving medical prescriptions for low-income senior citizens.
