BACKGROUND:

Summary

Per Welfare and Institutions Code 15763 (e), each county, to the extent resources are available, shall provide emergency shelter in the form of a safe haven or in-home protection for victims of elder or dependent adult abuse. Adult Protective Services generally places elders or dependent adults in emergency shelters for a period of up to thirty (30) days until the situation which brought them to the Department's attention can be resolved and/or a longer term living arrangement can be made.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) is responsible to protect elderly and dependent adults and needs to have a facility to house these vulnerable adults in emergency situations. The increase to the Maximum Reimbursable Amount (MRA) will continue to provide emergency services to Riverside County residents in harmful situations.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The funding for this Agreement is 100% Federal, State, County and Realignment funds, and was budgeted through the normal County budget process.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Agreement #AS-02061 was originally awarded by the Board of Supervisors on September 27, 2011 (Agenda #3.22) for the period October 1, 2011 through June 20, 2012 with options to renew through June 30, 2014, as a result of a competitive bid process.

In order to complete an in-process Request for Quote (RFQ), Purchasing issued a six (6) month Sole Source extension through December 31, 2014 for a Maximum Reimbursable Amount (MRA) not to exceed \$24,250, with the Occupied bed rate at \$85.00 per day and the Non-Occupied bed rate at \$50.00 per day. The Department of Public Social Services requests an increase to the MRA due to an increase in referrals for emergency shelter placements at the same bed rates. With the \$18,000 increase in MRA, the total six (6) month Agreement will not exceed \$42,250.

Currently, Purchasing has issued RFQ #DPARC-394 in Eastern Riverside County and will be recommending a new award to the Board of Supervisors on or before January 1, 2015.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT: AS-02061-07

CONTRACT TERM: July 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014

EFFECTIVE DATE OF AMENDMENT: July 1, 2014

MAXIMUM AMOUNT: \$42,250.00

The agreement between the Riverside County Department of Public Social Services, hereinafter referred to as DPSS, and Palm Springs Retirement Home, hereinafter referred to as Contractor, is amended in the following particulars and no others:

1. On the Recitals Page, and every page thereafter, amend all references to the contract number to read, "AS-02061-07".
2. On the Recitals Page, amend the MAXIMUM REIMBURSABLE AMOUNT to read, "\$42,250".
3. Delete Section III.B.1 MAXIMUM REIMBURSABLE AMOUNT in its entirety, and replace with,

"Total payment under this Contract shall not exceed \$42,250."


