

**BACKGROUND: CONTINUED:**

1. **Camp Del Corazon- \$2,000-** is a non-profit organization that provides year-round opportunities for children faced with the challenges of growing up and living with heart disease. To these children, the camp offers opportunities to finally be "normal"; to forget their ailments and to connect with others who have had similar experiences. The funding received will assist in direct camp expenses for children.
2. **The City of San Jacinto - \$17,000-** Funding will go specifically to operate the senior nutrition program that provides congregate and home delivered meals to 200 seniors in the Hemet & San Jacinto Valley out of San Jacinto Community Center.
3. **All From the Heart- \$1,000-** Holiday assistance program for veterans who live in the Third District.
