17	The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on October 7, 2014, before the					
18	Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor					
19	Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real					
20	property described as 19099 Driscoll Road, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside, Assessor's Parcel					
21	Number 645-250-004 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY."					
22	Sophia Choi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Michelle Cervantes, Senior Code					
23	Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department.					
24	Owner did not appear.					
25	The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer together					
26	with attached Exhibits, evidencing the substandard structure and accumulation of rubbish on THE					
27	PROPERTY as violations of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 and 541, and as a public					
28	nuisance.					

#### **SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE**

- 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the owner of THE PROPERTY as Sandra D. Schmidt ("OWNER").
- 2. Documents of title indicate that other parties may potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to wit: Internal Revenue Service (hereinafter referred to as "INTERESTED PARTY"). OWNER is deceased and property taxes are being paid by Julie Schmidt and Mark Schmidt (hereinafter collectively referred to as "SCHMIDT INTERESTED PARTIES").
- 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on March 12, 2012, and on seventeen (17) other occasions, the last being October 2, 2014.
- 4. During each inspection, a substandard structure (dwelling) was observed on THE PROPERTY. The structure was observed to be abandoned, dilapidated and vacant. The structure contained numerous deficiencies, including but not limited to: faulty weather protection; general dilapidation or improper maintenance; public and attractive nuisance abandoned/vacant.
- 5. During each inspection an accumulation of rubbish was observed throughout THE PROPERTY consisting of but not limited to: metal, plastic, wood, construction materials, furniture, appliances, and approximately five (5) tires in excess of 1,750 square feet.
- 6. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 and 541 by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 7. A Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings was recorded on May 17, 2012, as Document Number 2012-0229234 in the Office of the County Recorder, County of Riverside.
- 8. On March 12, 2012, Notice of Violation, Notice of Defects, a "Danger Do Not Enter" sign were posted on THE PROPERTY. On March 13, 2012, Notice of Violation and Notice of Defects was mailed to OWNER by certified mail with return receipt requested. On April 25, 2014, a Notice of Violation and Notice of Defects were mailed to OWNER and INTERESTED PARTY by first class mail. On June 4, 2014 and July 10, 2014, a Notice of Violation and Notice of Defects were mailed to OWNER and SCHMIDT INTERESTED PARTIES by first class mail.
- 9. A "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors, was mailed to OWNER and

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on October 7, 2014, finds and concludes that:

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WHEREAS, the substandard structure (dwelling) and accumulation of rubbish on the real property located at 19099 Driscoll Road, Desert Hot Springs, Riverside County, California, also

WHEREAS, the OWNER, occupants and any person having possession or control of 2.

THE PROPERTY shall abate the substandard structure conditions by razing, removing and disposing

of the substandard structure, including the removal and disposal of all structural debris and

materials, and contents therein or by reconstruction and rehabilitation of said structure provided that

said reconstruction or demolition can be accomplished in strict accordance with all Riverside County

Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 457 within ninety (90)

days.

WHEREAS, the OWNER, occupants and any other person having possession or 3. control of THE PROPERTY shall abate the accumulation of rubbish by removing and disposing of all rubbish on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 within ninety (90) days.

WHEREAS, the OWNER, INTERESTED PARTIES, AND SCHMIDT 4. INTERESTED PARTIES ARE HEREBY FURTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6.

#### ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the substandard structure (dwelling) on THE PROPERTY be abated by the OWNER, Sandra D. Schmidt, or anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY, by razing and removing the substandard structure including the removal and

disposal of all structural debris and materials, as well as the contents therein, or by reconstruction and rehabilitation of said structure provided such reconstruction and rehabilitation can be accomplished in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 457 within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order to Abate Nuisance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the substandard structure is not razed, removed and disposed of, or reconstructed and rehabilitated in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 457, within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the substandard structure, contents therein, and structural debris and materials, may be abated by representatives of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department, a contractor, or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of the owner's consent or a Court Order, where necessary, under applicable law authorizing entry onto THE PROPERTY.

FURTHERMORE, the OWNER is ordered to ascertain the existence or non-existence of asbestos containing materials in said structures by survey and materials sample testing by a duly licensed and certified asbestos consultant; and, prior to the abatement ordered hereinabove, to secure the removal of all asbestos containing materials discovered through such survey and testing by contract with a duly certified and licensed contractor for the handling of such materials to avoid citations and/or fines by South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY be abated by the OWNER or anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY, by removing and disposing of all rubbish from THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accumulation of rubbish is not removed and disposed of in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 541 within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the accumulation of rubbish may be abated by representatives of the Riverside County Code

Enforcement Department, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's consent or a Court Order when necessary under applicable law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable abatement costs, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457, 541, and 725. Under Riverside County Ordinance No. 725, "abatement costs" means "any costs or expenses reasonably related to the abatement of conditions which violate County Land Use Ordinances, and shall include, but not be limited to, enforcement, investigation, collection and administrative costs, attorneys fees, and the costs associated with the removal or correction of the violation." Reasonable abatement costs accrued by the Code Enforcement

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1	Department will be recoverable from the OWNER even if THE PROPERTY is brought into
2	compliance within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order to Abate Nuisance.


