

BACKGROUND:

- 1. The 20th Annual Steve Chase Awards Gala will be held at the Palm Springs Convention Center on February 7th 2015. Since 1995, the Steve Chase Humanitarian Awards Gala has raised millions of dollars for the Desert AIDS Projects direct client services. Services include: Primary and HIV-specialty care through the Wells Fargo HIV Health Center, Riverside County's HIV-specialty dental clinic, case management, and an onsite pharmacy.
- 2. The College of the Desert Public Safety Academy provides training and educational opportunities for students to pursue a career in public safety. Each semester an outstanding cadet in Basic Peace Officer Training Module II is selected for outstanding accomplishments and awarded a \$500 scholarship. The Basic Peace Officer Training Module II-Outstanding Cadet Award ceremony was held on December 18, 2014.
