Dear Mr. Bagheri:

We received a letter from your company sent to the County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) dated January 02, 2015 regarding the above referenced project (attached). On December 17, 2014, eight (8) bids were received in the Office of Director of Transportation and Land Management for the subject project. After the public bid opening, Riverside Construction Company, Inc. (Riverside Construction) was announced as the apparent low bidder and OHL USA, Inc. (OHL) was the second low bidder. See attached bid summary for verified cost information regarding all the 8 received bids.

Your request to declare Riverside Construction as a non-responsive bidder, and award this project to the second low bidder, OHL, is denied.

As requested by OHL, on Thursday December 18, 2014, the County provided OHL a scanned copy of the bid documents received from Riverside Construction via e-mail. Your company was also offered to review the original bid documents in our office. After your company's review of the bid documents, a bid protest letter was submitted.

Your letter basically discusses two issues and provides support information to declare the apparent low bidder as non-responsive: failure to conform to the bidding instructions regarding the percentage of work being subcontracted and the failure to list a subcontractor.

Percentage of Work Being Subcontracted

As mentioned in your letter and as required in the bid documents, a minimum of 50% of the work is required to be performed by the prime/general Contractor.

Your letter states that Riverside Construction listed an approximate percentage of work to be subcontracted in the amount of "43+/-%" and by submitting an approximation, that the bid is speculative and dependent of the magnitude of the "+/-"percentage. Riverside Construction's

Subcontractor List and Attachments A through P, submittals with their Bid, are included with this response letter.

We looked at your submitted copies of Caltrans letters sent to various contractors bidding on Caltrans projects that demonstrate examples of Caltrans rejecting bids for non-responsiveness. Caltrans is not administering this project. Listing an approximate percentage along with a "+/-" symbol on the County's Proposal Subcontractor List bid form is not grounds for rejection of this bid, is not a violation of a County condition, nor is it a Public Contract Code requirement.

The County's Subcontractor List bid form (page B12) does not require percentage amounts of each bid item subcontracted. The County's bid document requirements govern over the Standard Specifications. An estimated total of the work to be performed by subcontractors is acceptable so long as it is less than 50%. Additionally, Riverside Construction using "+/-" symbol is not irregular.

Instruction to Bidder's item 11, Subletting, Subcontracting, and Subcontractor List subsection Subcontractor List states that "*The County may request additional information to verify submitted Subcontractor List information and percentage amounts. Bidder must provide this information within two (2) business days of request.*"

It's the County's practice to regularly request for this additional information for the verification of subcontracted items and percentage amounts. The County requested Riverside Construction to submit a detailed summary in regards to their Subcontractor List. Riverside Construction's letter dated January 6, 2015 and detailed summary of subcontractor description of work, dollar amount and percentage, as requested by the County, is acceptable. Please note that the verified subcontractor percentage is approximately 36%. This letter and detailed summary documents are attached and will be submitted along with the project's award package.

Failure to List a Subcontractor

Your company's letter declares that: Riverside Construction confused the (subcontractor) issue by including various attachments to the Subcontractor List form, Riverside Construction failed to acknowledge the box designating the existence of such attachments, and that Attachment "H" of Riverside Construction's Subcontractor List was included but it did not correspond to a subcontractor named on the Subcontractor List.

The County has verified fifteen (15) subcontractors listed by Riverside Construction. Riverside Construction clearly submitted construction item number(s) and description information with their submittal included as Attachments A through P. All of these attachments, with the exception of Attachment "H", correspond to a listed subcontractor.

Attachment "H" was not assigned to any of the subcontractors listed nor did the Subcontractor List refer to Attachment "H". As required in Instruction to Bidder's Section 11, Subletting, Subcontracting, and Subcontractors List, omissions or failure to list a subcontractor for a portion of the work means that the prime Contractor will do that portion of the work (PCC Section 4106). As stated in the Instruction to Bidders Section 22, Bids, the foregoing provisions for the resolution of specific irregularities cannot be so comprehensive as to cover every omission, inconsistency, error or other irregularity which may occur in a bid... Additionally, the County reserves the right to waive any irregularity.

The unchecked box is minor irregularity that the County deems waived. It is waived at the County's discretion to best protect the public interest in the prompt commencement and economical completion of this project.

The County intends to award to Riverside Construction which is the responsive low bidder for this project.
