The Board of Supervisors commemorates her service to the County of Riverside.



An instrumental force in the community, he set up one of the Southland's finest county recreation programs at Sorenson Park, helped found the Whittier City Schools credit union, taught Sunday School at Whittier Presbyterian Church, and ran a successful family rentals business in Whittier and Joshua Tree.

In 1961 he attended Naval officer's candidate school in Rhode Island, but his stint with the Navy was cut short by arthritis of the spine.

For many years, Evan worked in the hospitality field at various hotels and restaurants including the Mission Inn, Hotel del Coronado, Du-par's restaurant, Old Virginia Steakhouse, the Palmer House, and the Del Rey Yacht Club in Southern California and Kontiki restaurant in Arizona. He also trained in interior design under Allen Edwards in Toronto in 1969 and worked for Joseph Andre Interiors in Beverly Hills from 1970 to 1973.
