#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary (continued)**

The continued specific services to be provided include, but are not limited to, plan check review of WQMP's and other WQMP and water quality protection assistance related to development activities. The Transportation Department is experiencing an increase in the number of WQMP's submitted for review due to increased development activity and as a result of shifting responsibilities for WQMP reviews from the Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) to the Transportation Department.

On January 7, 2014, Agenda Item 3-44, the Board approved Engineering Services Agreements for Water Quality Management Plan Review Services with RBF Consulting, AEI-CASC Consulting, and CValdo Corporation with a budget of \$75,000 annually for each contract for three years. Amendment No. 1 increases the contract amount for each contract to \$225,000 per year for Fiscal Year 14/15 and Fiscal Year 15/16.

The Fiscal Year 14/15 \$75,000 budgets have nearly all been exhausted. The increased budget will allow for development WQMP reviews to continue without interruption.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Transportation Department will be positioned to seamlessly and efficiently continue to review WQMP's in an expedient manner and provide certainty for the processing of the steady increase of development project submittals.

#### **SUPPLEMENTAL**

#### Additional Fiscal Information

All associated continued contract costs will be funded using the deposit-based fees submitted by proponents of private developments. No General Funds will be used.

#### Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The Board of Supervisors approved the original agreements on January 7, 2014, Agenda Item 3-44. This is the first amendment to these agreements.

California law requires selection of engineering service consultants on the basis of demonstrated competence and professional qualifications. Local agencies may not use cost solely as a basis for selection. Contracts must be negotiated in order of the most qualified firms at prices determined to be fair and reasonable to the local agency. In addition, the County's Purchasing Department policies define authority and responsibility for procurement and authorization of services.

The contract and rates for services were developed by negotiations between the selected consultants and Transportation Department staff using the guidelines noted above. The three recommended consultant rates are consistent with the current District's On-call Plan Check consultants providing similar services. These rates have not changed with the respective amendments.

The Transportation Department apportions the work among the three firms based on a number of factors, such as work load, continuity, and special expertise and strength specific to the project under review.

THIS AMENDMENT (hereinafter the "1st Amendment") to an Agreement is made and entered into as of this day of March, 2015, by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter the "COUNTY"), and RBF Consulting (hereinafter "ENGINEER").

#### RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ENGINEER entered in an Agreement entitled "On-Call Water Quality Management Plan Check Services between County of Riverside Transportation Department and RBF Consulting" dated January 7, 2014, Agenda Item 3.44 (hereinafter the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides the terms and conditions, scope of work, schedule and budget for the performance of professional and technical services necessary to provide on-call services.
- B. Due to an increased amount of development activities, the amount of compensation is required to be increased to provide timely and efficient services in review of Water Quality Management Plans being submitted to the COUNTY.
- C. The parties therefore now desire to amend the compensation amount for Fiscal Years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016.

#### **AGREEMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. Article VI – COMPENSATION subsection B.1. is amended by deleting the sentence "The total amount of the contract is not to exceed \$75,000 per Fiscal Year and reimbursement is to be made at actual cost." And replacing with the following: "The total amount of the contract is not to exceed \$75,000 for Fiscal Year 2013/2014, and \$225,000 for each of Fiscal Year 2014/2015 and Fiscal Year 2015/2016."

In Appendix C · Article CV of the original Agreement, the article is deleted and replaced with the following: "The following cost proposal reflects the negotiated targeted contract amount. The cost proposal will serve as a guideline and reference document during the execution of the contract.

ENGINEER shall be compensated in accordance with the rates provided. The total amount of the contract is not to exceed \$75,000 for Fiscal Year 2013/2014, and \$225,000 for each of the Fiscal Years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016. Reimbursement is to be made at actual cost. Billing shall not exceed the rates provided in the attached Fee Proposal Worksheets (Exhibit C-1 attached hereto and incorporated herein). Services will be requested on an "as needed" basis for Fiscal Years 2013/2014, 2014/2015 and 2015/2016. ENGINEER will provide services for an amount not to exceed \$75,000 for Fiscal Year 2013/2014, and \$225,000 for each of Fiscal Year 2014/2015 and 2015/2016, with no minimum amount and invoicing only for services performed. The total amount is not to exceed \$525,000 for the three year term. This Agreement may be cancelled by COUNTY without cause with 30 days written notice and may be extended by no more than two one year extensions (Board authorization required).

Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and conditions
of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.
