1. Approve Contract Change Order No. 2 (CCO No. 2) in the amount of \$145,015.05, to the Contract with Road Builders, Inc. (Contractor) for additional work at the Badlands and Highgrove landfills.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On September 23, 2014, the Board awarded the Contractor the contract for the Construction of the 2014 Site Maintenance and Improvement Project at multiple sites including Badlands, Lamb Canyon, Highgrove, Menifee, and Beaumont landfills. The total contract amount was \$1,409,656.90.

On November 21, 2014, the Lamb Canyon Landfill was subjected to a heavy rainstorm that caused severe damage to a drainage/liner termination bench within the recently completed Phase 2, Stage 4 expansion area. (continued)

BACKGROUND: (cont.)

In order to protect the liner system from further damage, the Department directed the Contractor to implement the necessary repair work. On December 1, 2014, the Department's General Manager-Chief Engineer approved Contract Change Order No.1 (CCO No.1) in the amount of \$75,000 to complete this work. The Contractor completed the repair work on December 15, 2014, for a total cost of \$29,696.23, which is \$45,303.77 below the authorized amount for CCO No.1.

In December 2014, four significant rain events produced a total of three-plus inches of rain, which restricted public access to the active disposal area within the new Canyon 4, Phase 3 expansion area at the Badlands Landfill, and also caused damage to the final landfill cover system at the Highgrove Landfill. These conditions increased the required drainage improvement quantities under the contract for a total amount of \$111,161.82. It is recommended that the Department utilize the remaining \$45,303.77 from CCO No., 1 along with an additional amount of \$65,858.05 in the attached CCO No.2, to compensate the contractor.

Department staff also needs to abandon two pipe culverts by means of pressure grout/slurry backfill, and patching the geosynthetic liner system at the downstream end of the recently completed expansion area at the Badlands Landfill. This work is necessary to allow the disposal activities to progress vertically within the expansion area. The Contractor has submitted a quote of \$79,157.00 to implement the work, and the Department has deemed the quoted price to be reasonable based on similar work at the Lamb Canyon Landfill. This work is also included in the attached CCO No. 2.

The total contract amount increase due to CCO No.2 is \$145,015.05 (\$65,858.05 and \$79,157.00), thus increasing the final project cost to \$1,629,671.95.

This adjustment has resulted in quantity increase, decrease, or elimination of several bid items including, but not limited to, concrete & shotcrete drainage structures (increase), earthen berm & landfill access road at Highgrove landfill (increase), soil cement roadway (decrease), greenwaste application over slopes (decrease) and onsite rock relocation (elimination).
