



BACKGROUND: CONTINUED:

- 1. Riverside County Reg. Med. Center Sexual Assault Response Team, (SART) and Riverside County Child Assessment Team, (RCCAT) - \$1500** the funding will support the SART and RCCAT Conference which will educate and raise awareness of issue of abuse. The conference target audience includes law enforcement, health care providers, first responders, advocates, counselors and mental health professionals to better serve the residents of Riverside County.
- 2. Riverside County Economic Development – Workforce Division Character Counts Youth Awards - \$1,000** will provide sponsorship for volunteer youth awards that promote positive character in young people based on six pillars of character: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship.
- 3. TruEvolution- \$2,500** allocation will support the TruEvolution leadership academy which helps young people access academic resources and career prep training.
- 4. Law enforcement Appreciation Committee, (LEAC) - \$500** Sponsorship of the 37th annual law enforcement appreciation ceremony recognizing outstanding law enforcement officers for excellence in community services.
