The City of Riverside has complied with this requirement (Exhibit A) and has requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct its election. The department has the resources to provide these services. The County will receive reimbursements from the jurisdiction based on associated direct costs of conducting their election.

RESOLUTION NO. 22793

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 2, 2015, TO BE CONDUCTED WHOLLY BY MAIL-IN BALLOT IN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL FROM THE FIRST, THIRD, FIFTH, AND SEVENTH WARDS OF SAID CITY OF RIVERSIDE.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1: That in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Riverside and the Constitution and election laws of the State of California, a General Municipal Election be held and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of Riverside on June 2, 2015, for the purpose of electing four members of the City Council of the City of Riverside. The members of the City Council shall be from the odd-numbered wards of the City of Riverside as established by the City Council.

Section 2: That no polling places will be secured as said election is to be conducted wholly by mail-in ballot. Official ballots will be mailed together with the sample ballot pamphlet and a postage prepaid envelope for return of the official ballot. Voted ballots must be returned to the Registrar of Voters Office or to one of the drop-off locations, at least one of which shall be located in Ward One, Ward Three, Ward Five and Ward Seven. Voted ballots must be returned no later than 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday June 2, 2015.

Section 3: That the purpose of holding said General Municipal Election there shall be and hereby are established consolidated voting precincts consisting of a consolidation of the regular precincts in the City of Riverside established for the holding of state and county elections as said regular election precincts exist on the date of this resolution.

Section 4: That the form and contents of the ballots to be used at said election shall be as provided by law.

Section 5: That in accordance with section 10002 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County are hereby requested to consent to the Riverside County Registrar of Voters rendering election services to the City of Riverside as may be requested by the City Clerk of said City, the County of Riverside to be reimbursed in full for such services as

RESOLUTION NO. 22806

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, PLACING A MEASURE ON THE BALLOT FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ON THE 2ND DAY OF JUNE, 2015, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, INITIATIVE **MEASURE** TO RESCIND THE **RIVERSIDE'S** BAN ON STOREFRONT AND **MOBILE** MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES.

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2013, proponents Michael Eppolito and Kimberly Thompson filed in the City Clerk's Office a Notice of Intent to Circulate Petition for the purpose of adopting amendments to the Riverside Municipal Code relating to storefront and mobile marijuana dispensaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney prepared the Ballot Title and Summary, which titled the initiative as "An Initiative Measure to Rescind the City of Riverside's Ban on Storefront and Mobile Marijuana Dispensaries"; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2014, the initiative petitions were filed in the Office of the City Clerk; the total number of signature submitted and checked by the Riverside County Registrar was 20,206; the total number of sufficient signatures was 13,640; and the total number of insufficient signatures was 6,566; and

WHEREAS, the minimum number of 13,368 signatures required to call a special election was exceeded; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has prepared a report declaring sufficiency of the initiative petitions.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside as follows:

Section 1: The City Council, pursuant to its right and authority under Elections Code section 9215, hereby orders that the following question be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a General Municipal Election to be held on June 2, 2015.

Should "An Initiative Measure to Rescind the City of Riverside's Ban on Storefront and Mobile Marijuana Dispensaries" be adopted?

Section 2: The City Clerk is hereby authorized, instructed and directed to take all action necessary to place the measure described herein on the General Municipal Election ballot for the General Municipal Election on June 2, 2015.

Section 3: That in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Riverside and the Constitution and election laws of the State of California, a measure is hereby added to the General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Riverside on June 2, 2015, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Riverside the following entitled initiative: "An Initiative Measure to Rescind the City of Riverside's Ban on Storefront and Mobile Marijuana Dispensaries."

Section 4: That no polling places will be secured as said election is to be conducted wholly by mail-in ballot. Official ballots will be mailed together with the sample ballot pamphlet and a postage prepaid envelope for return of the official ballot. Voted ballots must be returned to the Registrar of Voters Office or to one of the drop-off locations, at least one of which shall be located in each City ward. Voted ballots must be returned no later than 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday June 2, 2015, or postmarked by June 2, 2015, and received by the Registrar of Voters by June 5, 2015.

Section 5: That the City Council consents to the consolidation of the General Municipal Election hereby called with all other elections being held in the same territory on June 2, 2015, and said elections, where possible, shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election within the City of Riverside and only one form of ballot shall be used and the voting precincts shall be the same as provided for the General Municipal Election.

Section 6: That for the purpose of holding said General Municipal Election there shall be and hereby are established consolidated voting precincts, consisting of a consolidation of the regular election precincts in the City of Riverside established for the holding of state and county elections as said regular election precincts exist on the date of this resolution.

<u>Section 7</u>: That the form and contents of the ballots to be used at the said elections shall be as provided by law.

Section 8: That in accordance with Section 10002 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County is hereby requested to consent to the Registrar of Voters rendering election services to the City of Riverside as may be requested by the City Clerk of said City, the County of Riverside to be reimbursed in full for such services as are performed.

Section 10: That the City Clerk shall have charge of all City elections pursuant to Riverside City Charter Section 703(f).

<u>Section 11:</u> That the City Clerk is hereby designated the "Elections Official" for the purposes of this election pursuant to Elections Code section 320(b).

Section 12: That based upon the foregoing authority, the City Clerk shall have charge of this election and shall make all determinations necessary to conducting this election.

Section 13: That the City Clerk of said City shall receive the canvass of the General Municipal Election and shall certify the results to this City Council, as required by law.

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
