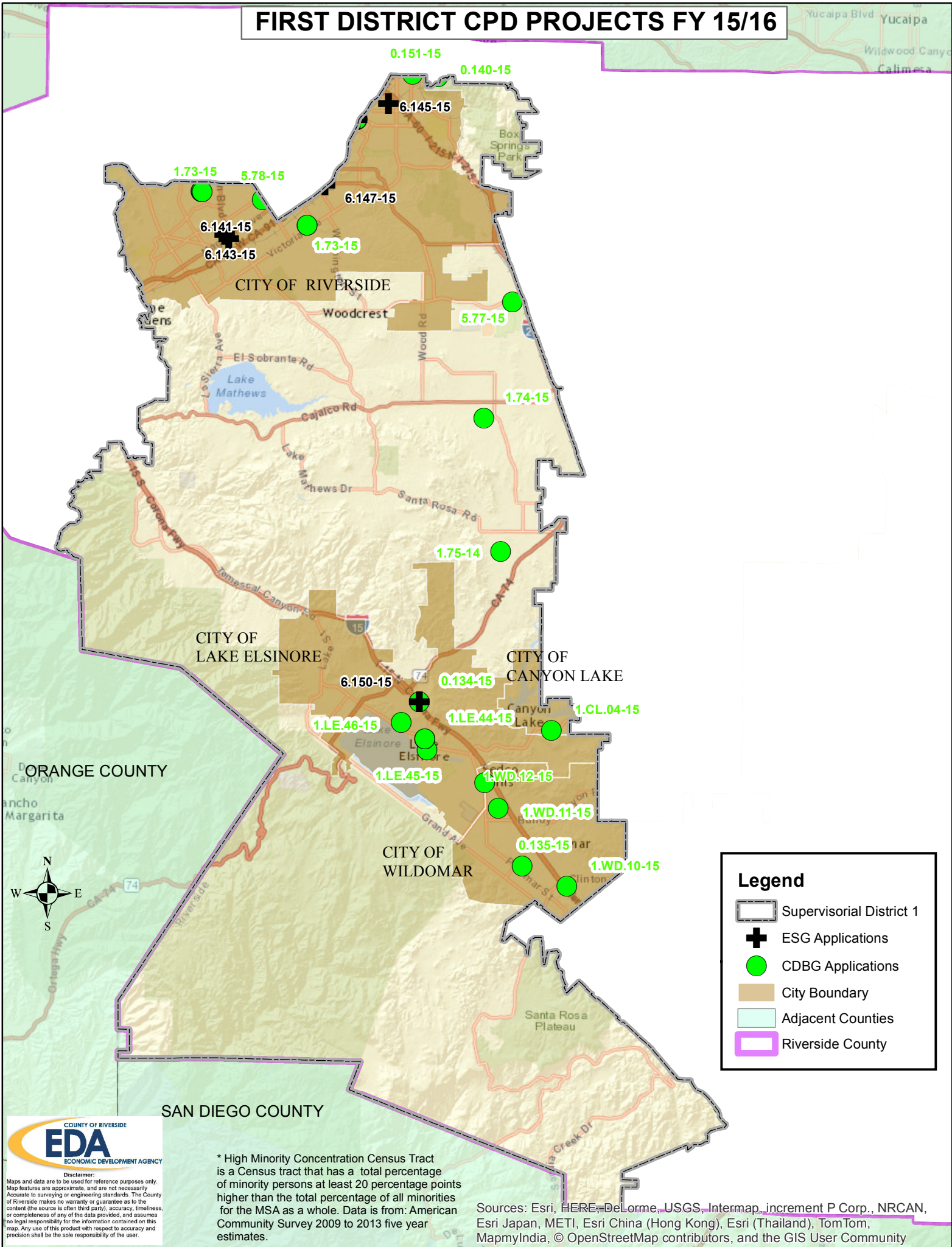

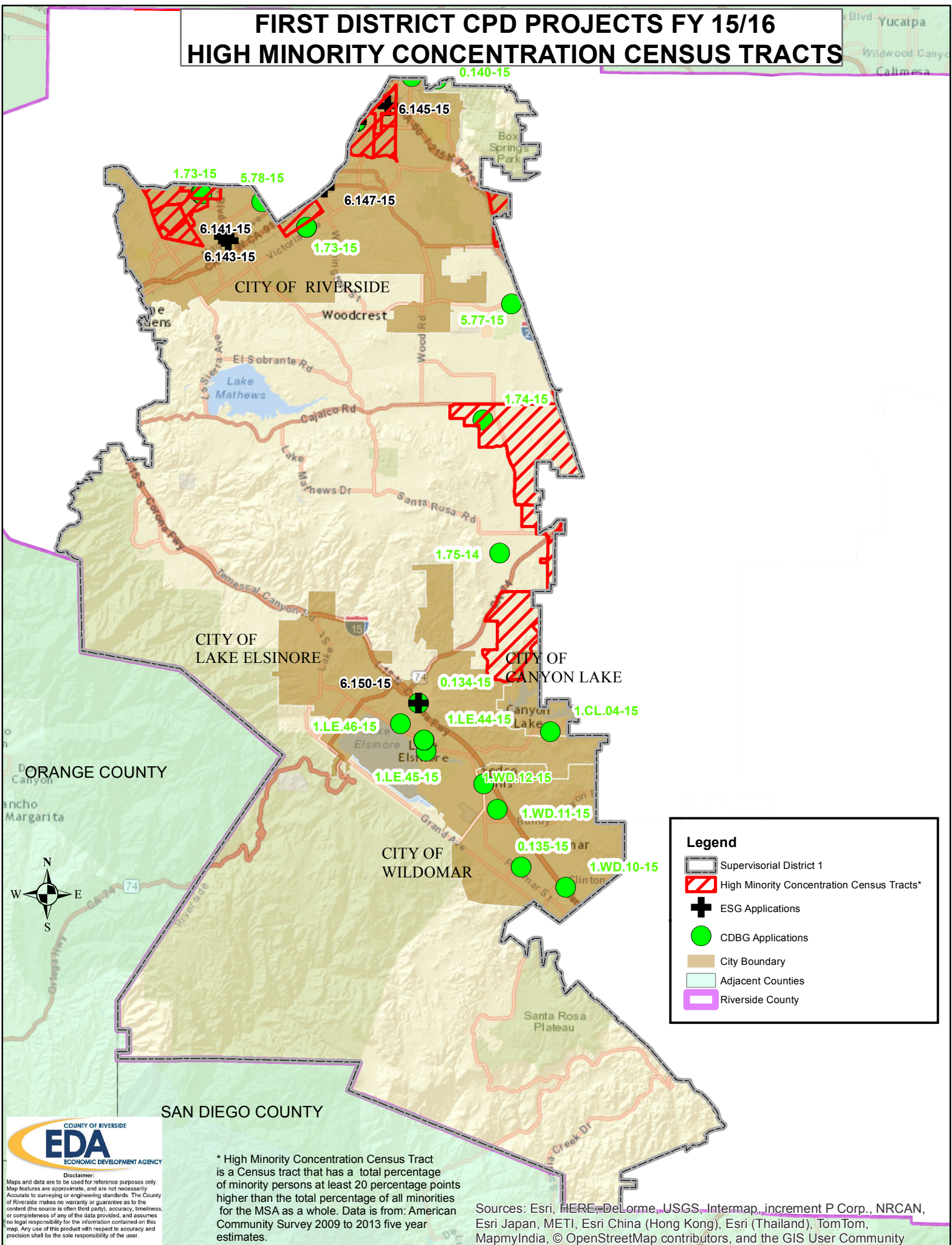

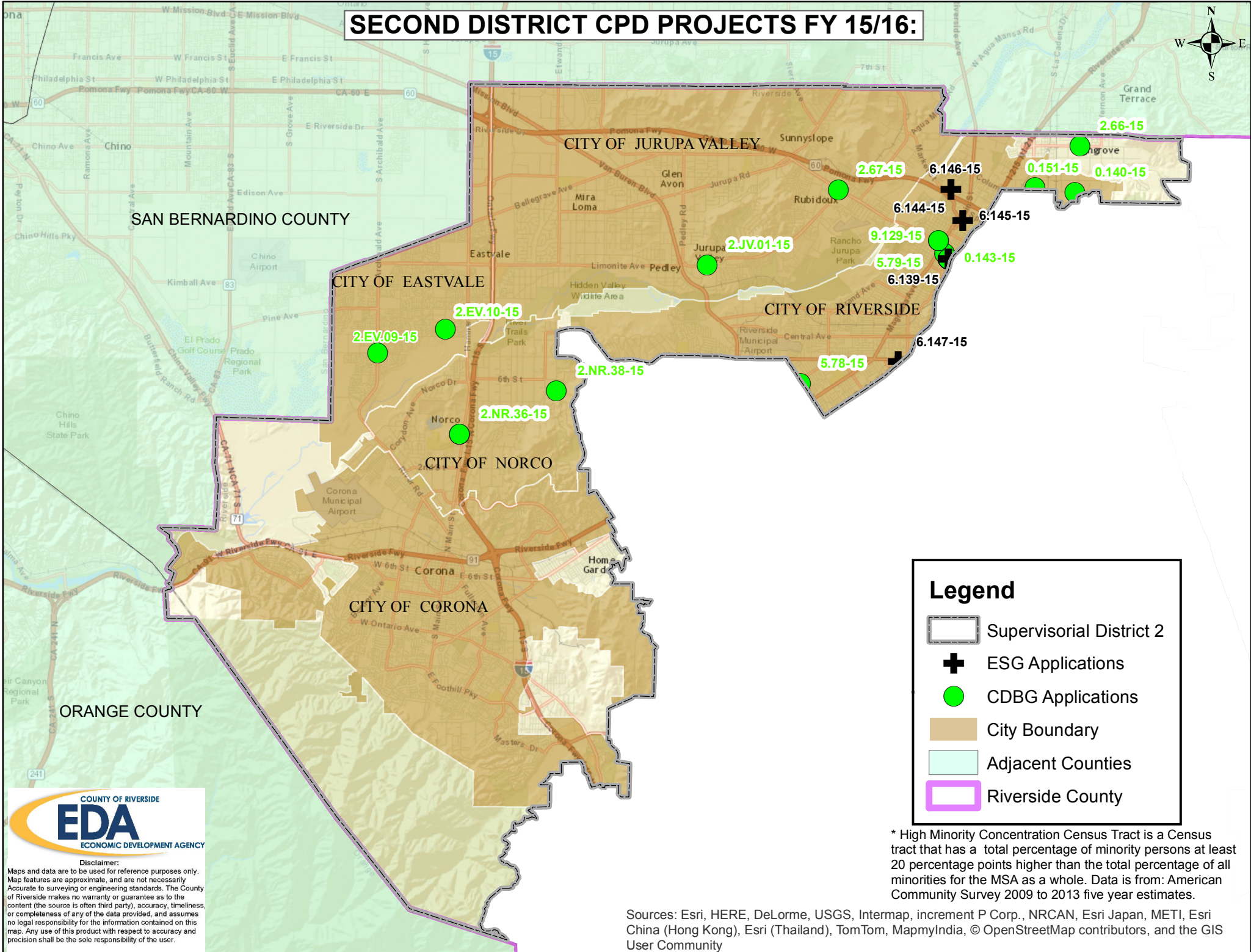


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SECOND DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16:

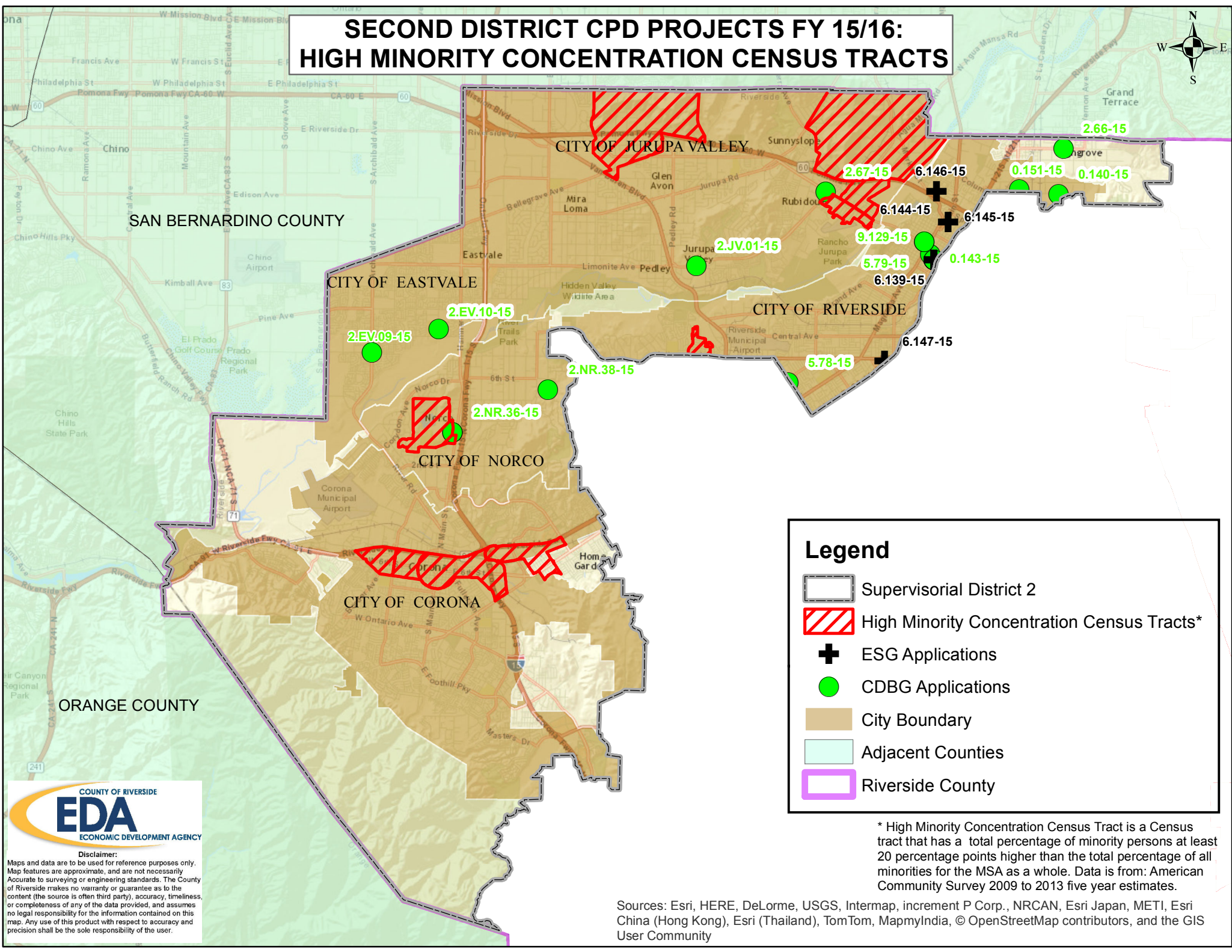
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SECOND DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16: HIGH MINORITY CONCENTRATION CENSUS TRACTS

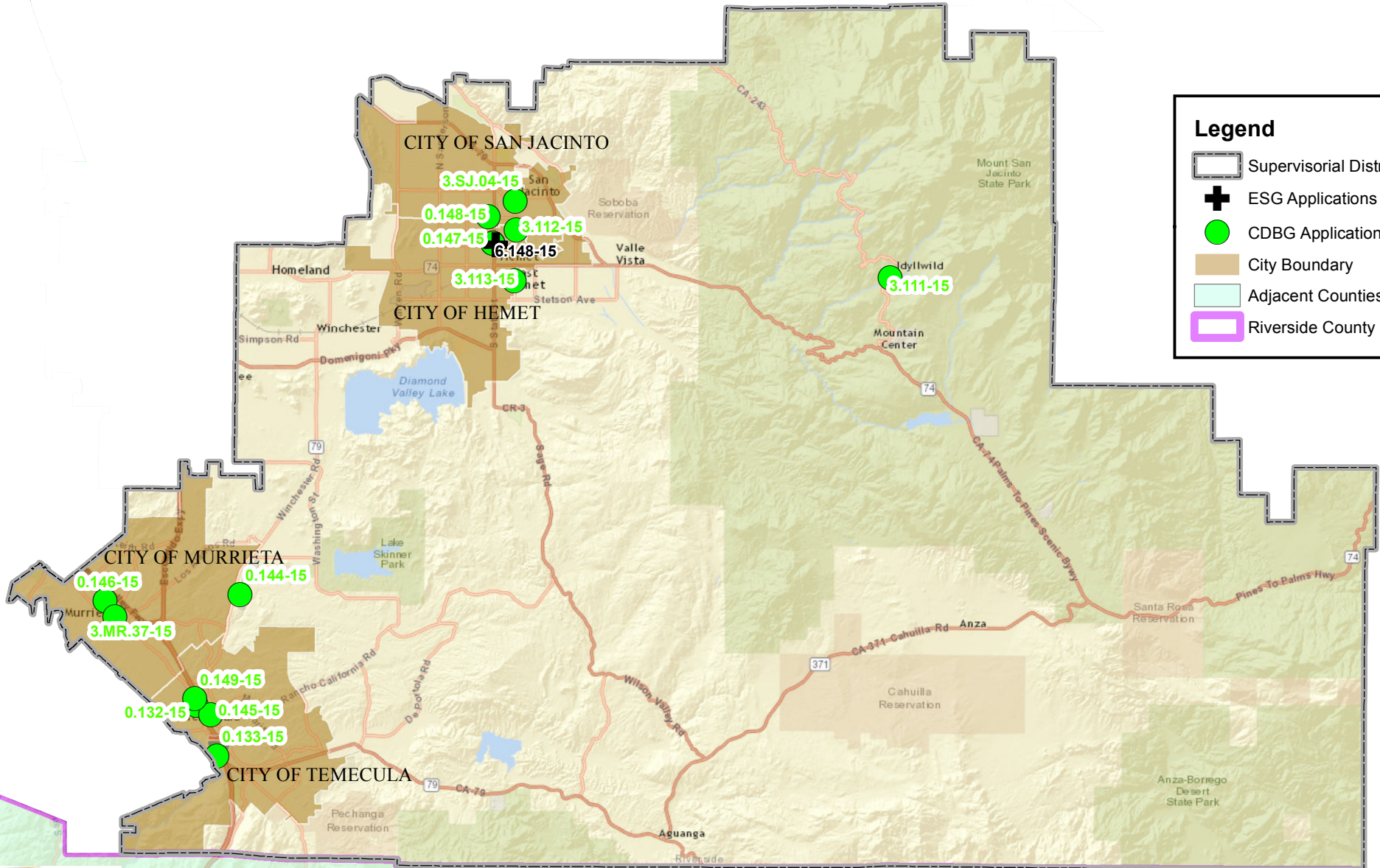
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THIRD DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16

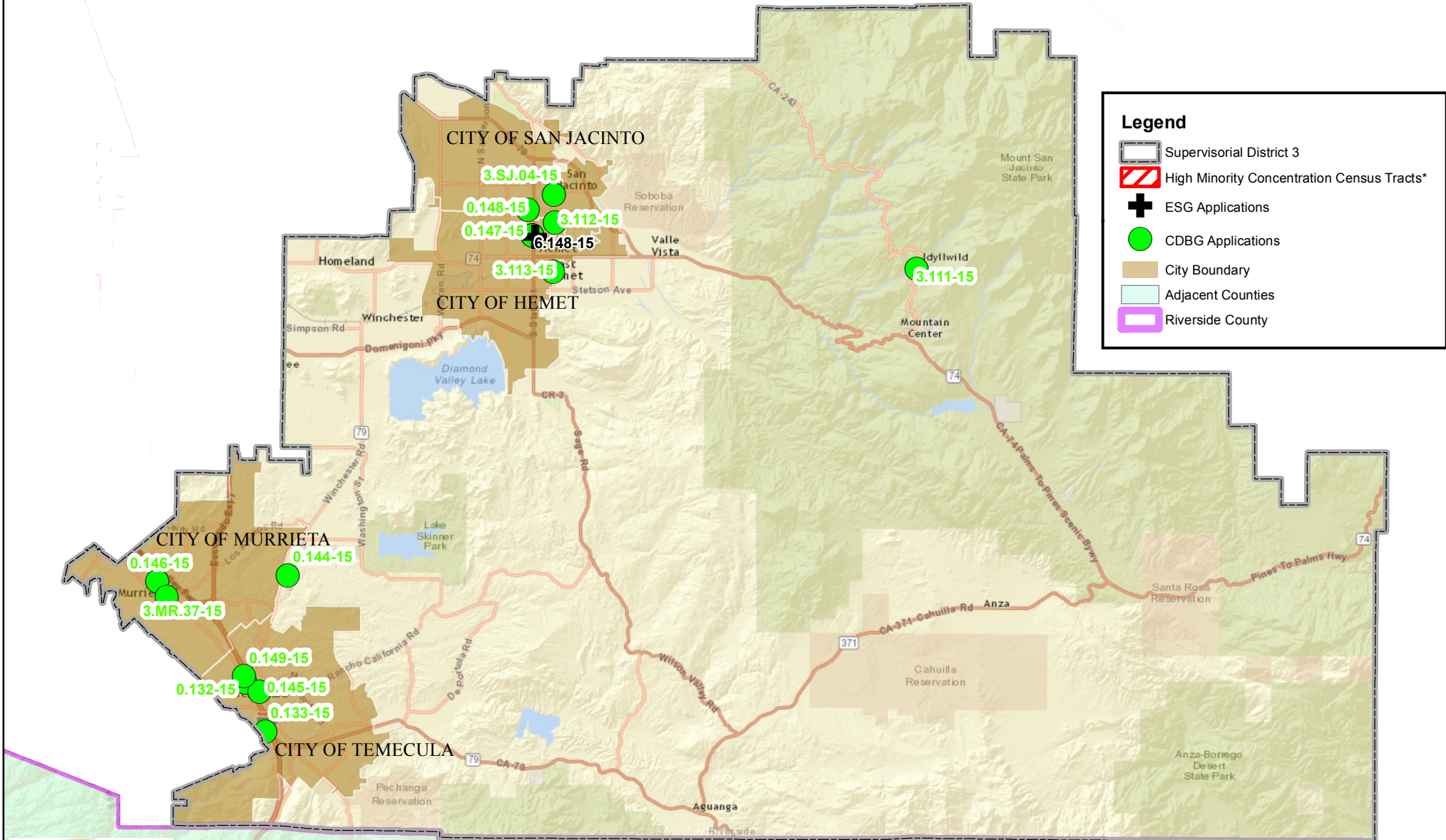


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THIRD DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16 HIGH MINORITY CONCENTRATION CENSUS TRACTS

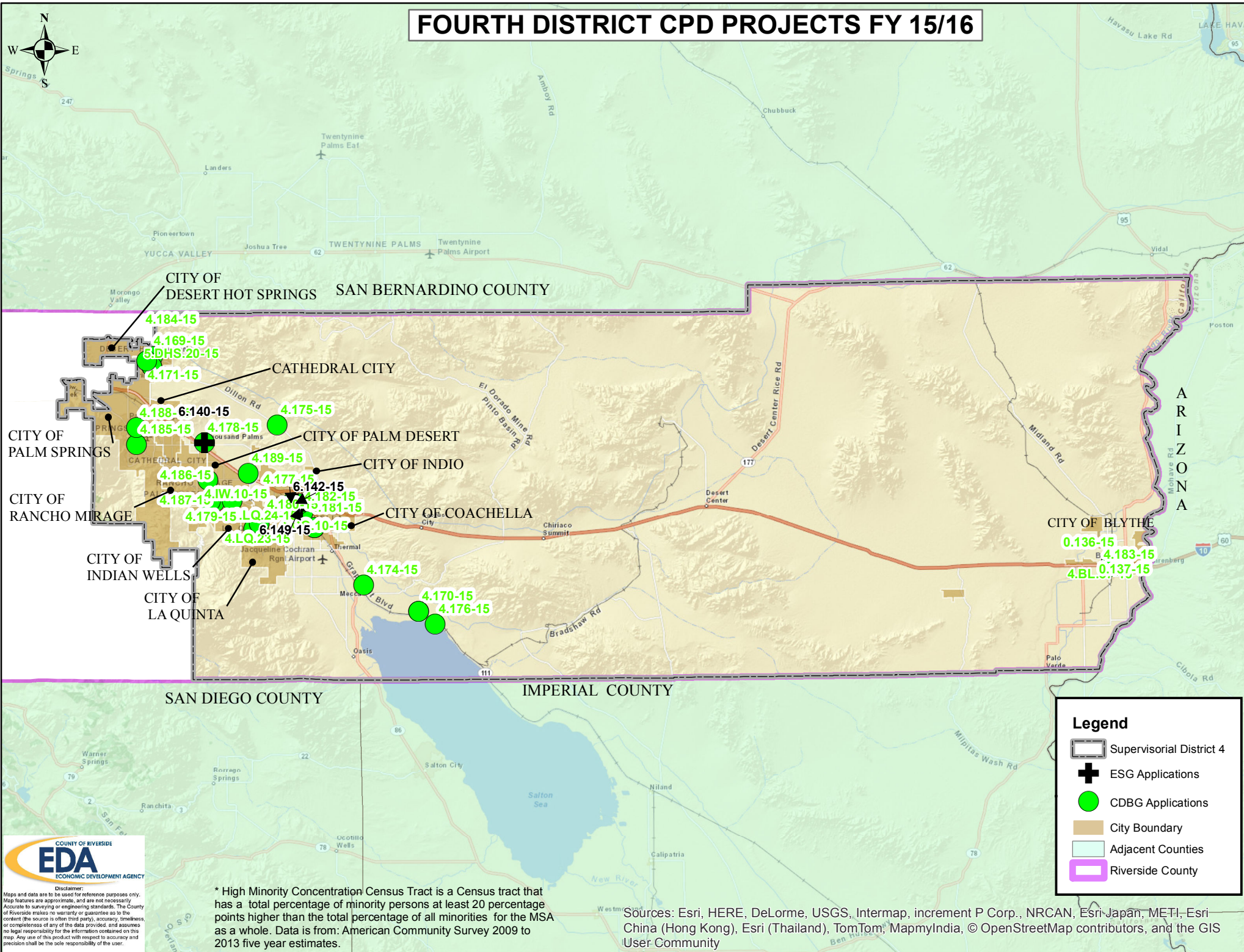



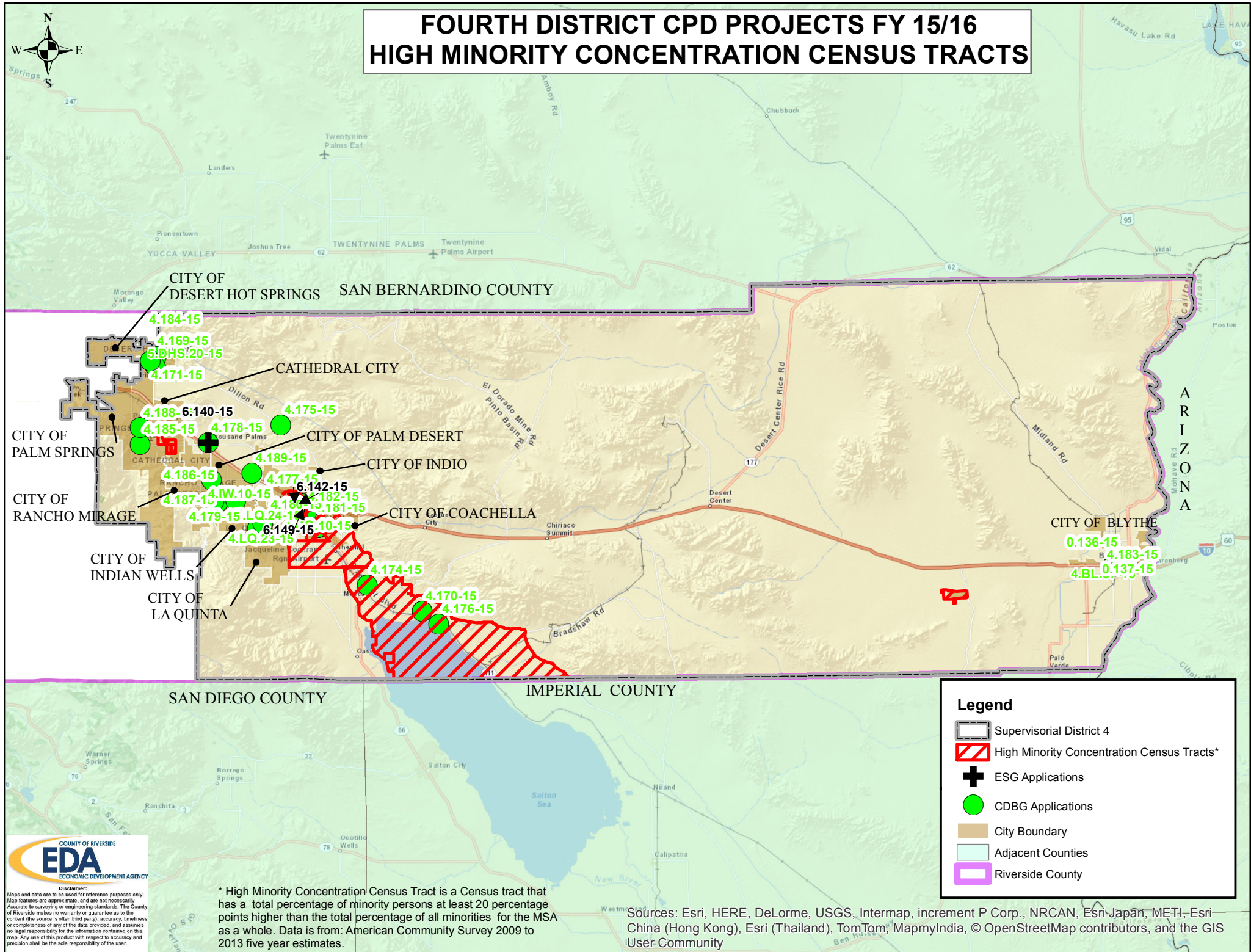


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FOURTH DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16 HIGH MINORITY CONCENTRATION CENSUS TRACTS



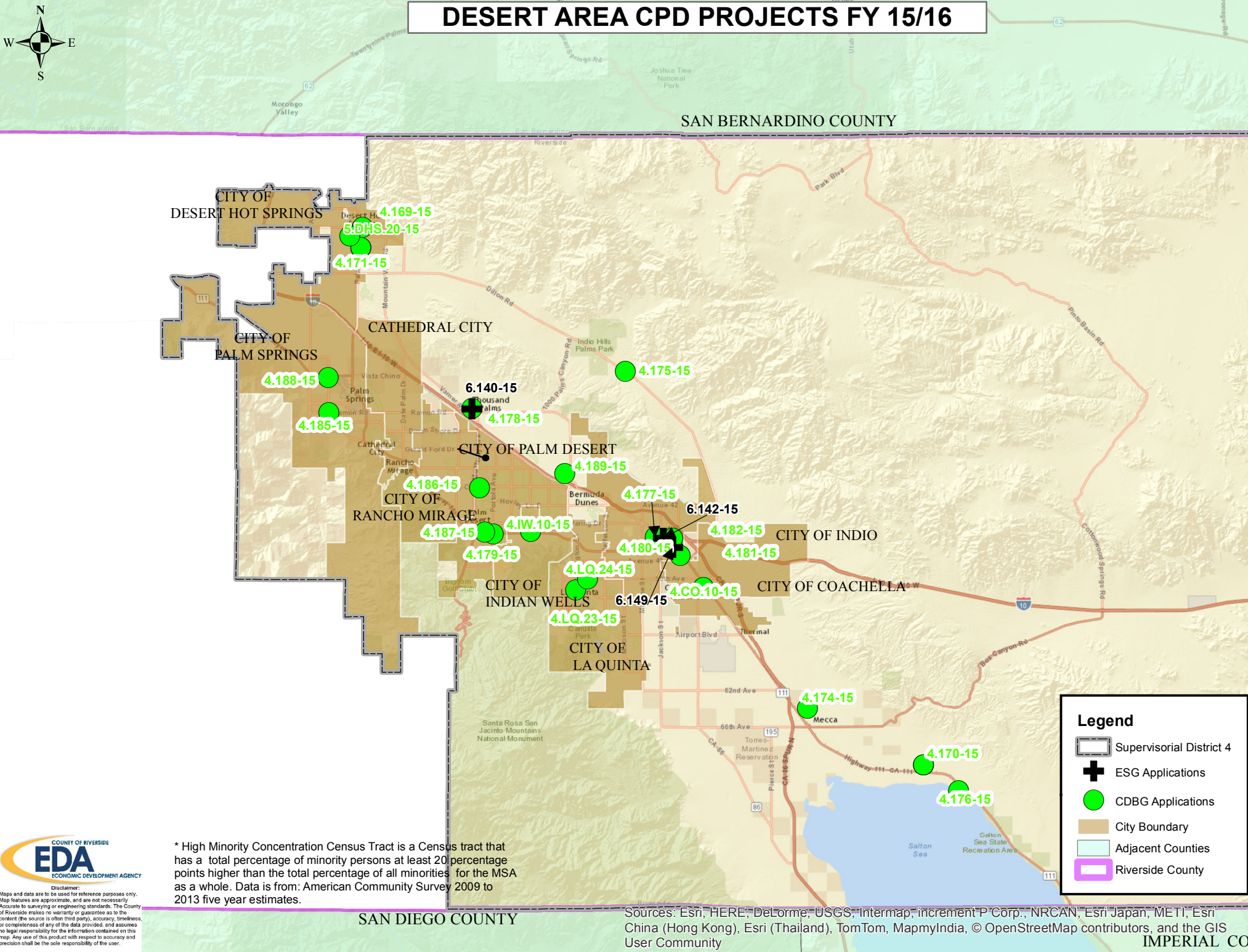

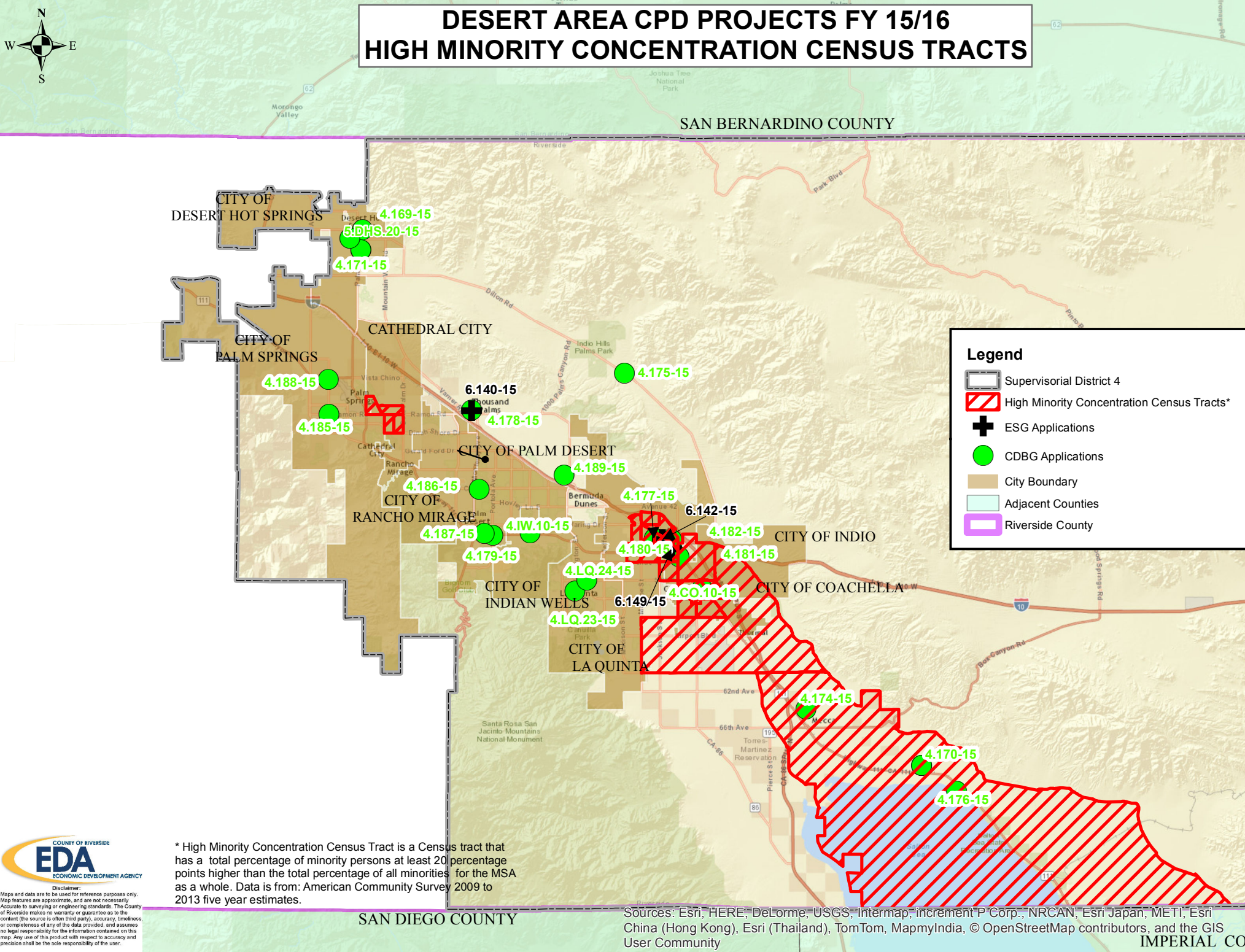

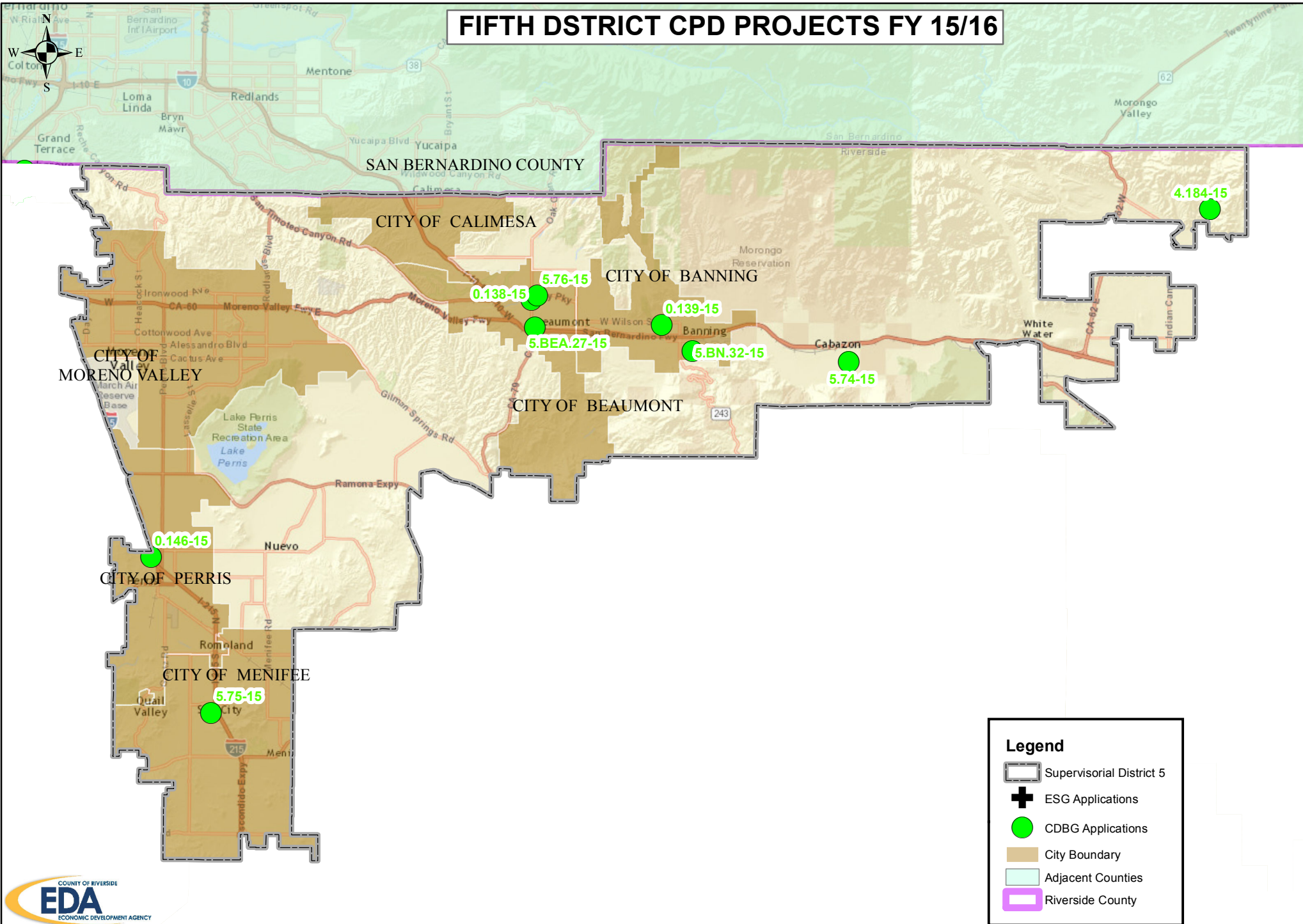

FIFTH DISTRICT CPD PROJECTS FY 15/16



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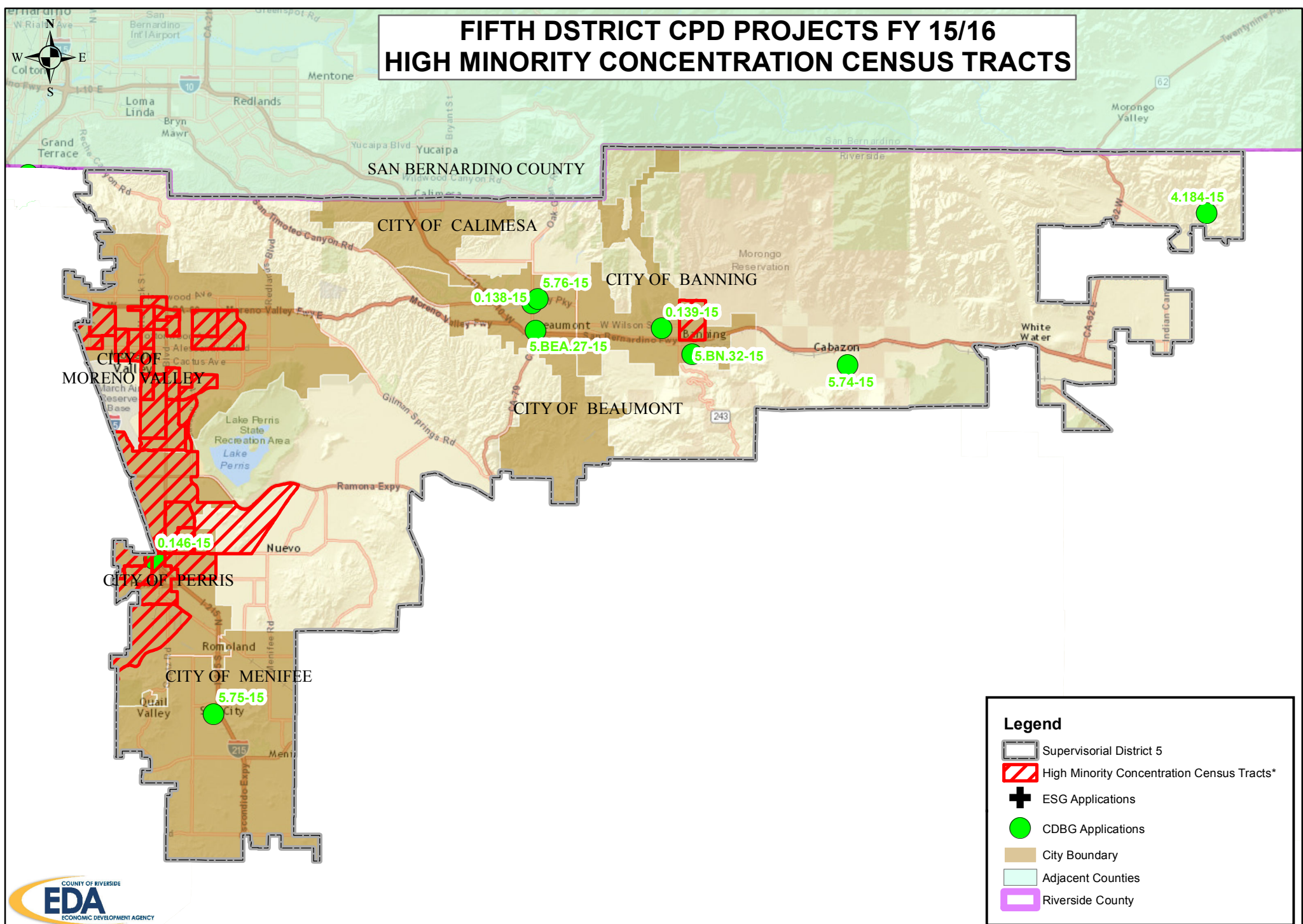
