BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the radar-enforceable speed limits recommended by the Transportation Department are summarized in the attached tables and have been determined to be appropriate to facilitate the safe and orderly movement of vehicular traffic.

Transportation Department staff has contacted the Blythe, Indio, Riverside, and San Gorgonio area offices of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) regarding the recommended speed zones.

The Ordinance amendment has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The establishing and posting of appropriate speed limits promote safe and orderly movements of vehicular traffic and enable the CHP to use radar equipment to enforce the speed limits. Since the recommended speed limits were determined based on actual speed surveys, the majority of the motorists are already driving at or below the recommended speed limits. Posted speed limits also guide motorists to drive at a reasonable speed in unfamiliar locations.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The cost for establishing the recommended speed limits is primarily for the installation of speed limit signs, which is estimated at about \$5,000.

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452

RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> Section 2.1 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Twenty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 7 to read as follows:
 - "7. On Double View Drive between McMahon Road to the end of the road, a total distance of approximately 1.6 miles, in the Idyllwild area."
- Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 127, 128, and 129 to read as follows:
 - "127. On Alexander Street between Rider Street and Cajalco Road, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the Perris area.
 - 128. On Middleton Street from a point 1,290 feet south of SH-86/Harrison Street to 66th Avenue/Tyler Street, a total distance of 0.9 miles, in the Thermal area,
 - 129. On Stetson Avenue, on the southerly half from Santa Fe Street to a point 650 feet east of Santa Fe Street, and the full width between a point 650 feet east of Santa Fe Street and Soboba Street, a total distance of approximately 2.51 miles, in the Hemet area."
- Section 3. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 145 to read as follows:
 - "145. On Box Springs Mountain Road from a point 1,300 feet west of Running Gun Lane to Pigeon Pass Road, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the Moreno Valley area."

Section 8. Subsection 45 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 45 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Middleton Street between Highway 86 and the centerline of 66th Avenue.

Section 9. Subsection 48 of Section 2.4 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 48 of Section 2.4 established a forty miles per hour speed limit on Cherry Valley Boulevard between the centerline of Bellflower Avenue and the centerline of Highland Springs Avenue.

Section 10. Subsection 73 of Section 2.6 of Ordinance 452 adopted on January 28, 2014, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.235, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 73 of Section 2.6 established a fifty miles per hour speed limit on the full width of Pigeon Pass Road between Box Springs Mountain Road and a point 1,300 feet north of Hidden Springs Drive; and on the westerly half between a point 1,300 feet north of Hidden Springs Drive and Hidden Springs Drive.

Section 11. Subsection 158 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 adopted on January 28, 2014, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.235, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 158 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Box Springs Mountain Road between a point 1,300 feet west of Running Gun Lane and Pigeon Pass Road.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452 RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.1 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Twenty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 7 to read as follows:

- "7. On Double View Drive between McMahon Road to the end of the road, a total distance of approximately 1.6 miles, in the Idyllwild area."
- Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 127, 128, and 129 to read as follows:
 - "127. On Alexander Street between Rider Street and Cajalco Road, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the Perris area.
 - 128. On Middleton Street from a point 1,290 feet south of SH-86/Harrison Street to 66th Avenue/Tyler Street, a total distance of 0.9 miles, in the Thermal area.
 - 129. On Stetson Avenue, on the southerly half from Santa Fe Street to a point 650 feet east of Santa Fe Street, and the full width between a point 650 feet east of Santa Fe Street and Soboba Street, a total distance of approximately 2.51 miles, in the Hemet area."
- Section 3. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 145 to read as follows:
 - "145. On Box Springs Mountain Road from a point 1,300 feet west of Running Gun Lane to Pigeon Pass Road, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the Moreno Valley area."
- Section 4. Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452, entitled "Forty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 165, 166, 167 & 168 to read as follows:
 - "165. On Black Rock Road between Dracker Drive and Mesa Drive, a total distance of approximately 1.3 miles, in the Blythe area.
 - 166. On Briggs Road, on the easterly half between Watson Road and Mapes Road, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the Homeland area.
 - 167. On Cherry Valley Boulevard between Bellflower Avenue and Highland Springs Avenue, a total distance of approximately 0.7 miles, in the Beaumont area.
 - 168. On Pigeon Pass Road between Box Springs Mountain Road to 1,300 feet north of Hidden Springs Drive, and the westerly half from 1,300 feet north of Hidden Springs Drive to Hidden Springs Drive, a total distance of approximately 0.9 miles, in the Moreno Valley area."
- Section 5. Section 2.6 of Ordinance 452, entitled "Fifty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 79 & 80 to read as follows:
 - "79. On Juniper Flats Road from SH-74 to Contour Avenue, a total distance of approximately 5.9 miles, in the Homeland area.

80. On Monroe Avenue, on the easterly half width from 62nd Avenue to 61st Avenue, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the La Quinta area."

Section 6. Subsection 4 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4. 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 4 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Stetson Avenue between Santa Fe Avenue and Hemet Street.

Section 7. Subsection 38 of Section 2.4 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 38 of Section 2.4 established a forty miles per hour speed limit on Briggs Road from the centerline of Watson Road to the centerline of Mapes Road.

Section 8. Subsection 45 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 45 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Middleton Street between Highway 86 and the centerline of 66th Avenue.

Section 9. Subsection 48 of Section 2.4 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 4. 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 48 of Section 2.4 established a forty miles per hour speed limit on Cherry Valley Boulevard between the centerline of Bellflower Avenue and the centerline of Highland Springs Avenue.

Subsection 73 of Section 2.6 of Ordinance 452 adopted on January 28, Section 10. 2014, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.235, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 73 of Section 2.6 established a fifty miles per hour speed limit on the full width of Pigeon Pass Road between Box Springs Mountain Road and a point 1,300 feet north of Hidden Springs Drive; and on the westerly half between a point 1,300 feet north of Hidden Springs Drive and Hidden Springs Drive.

Subsection 158 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 adopted on January 28. Section 11. 2014, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.235, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 158 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Box Springs Mountain Road between a point 1,300 feet west of Running Gun Lane and Pigeon Pass Road.

> Section 12. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.

Any person wishing to testify in support of or in opposition may do so in writing between the date of this notice and the public hearing, or may appear and be heard at the time and place noted above. All written comments received prior to the public hearing will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors and the Board of Supervisors will consider such comments, in addition to any oral testimony, before making a decision on the item.

If you challenge the above item in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence to the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing. Be advised that as a result of the public hearing. and the consideration of all public comment, written and oral, the Board of Supervisors may amend, in whole or in part, the item.

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the radar-enforceable speed limits recommended by the Transportation Department are summarized in the attached tables and have been determined to be appropriate to facilitate the safe and orderly movement of vehicular traffic.

Transportation Department staff has contacted the Blythe, Indio, Riverside, and San Gorgonio area offices of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) regarding the recommended speed zones.

The Ordinance amendment has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The establishing and posting of appropriate speed limits promote safe and orderly movements of vehicular traffic and enable the CHP to use radar equipment to enforce the speed limits. Since the recommended speed limits were determined based on actual speed surveys, the majority of the motorists are already driving at or below the recommended speed limits. Posted speed limits also guide motorists to drive at a reasonable speed in unfamiliar locations.

Additional Fiscal Information

The cost for establishing the recommended speed limits is primarily for the installation of speed limit signs, which is estimated at about \$5,000.
