**Summary**



Altie is a Member of VFW Post 1956 Sun City/Menifee; Member, MOAA Riverside-March Chapter; committee chair, Riverside Area Veterans Expo; Member, Pass Area Veterans Expo committee. He is currently a Field Representative with State Senator Richard Roth's office.

Marquis Palmer served in the U.S. Marine Corps from August 1, 2005 through November 21, 2012. He made two deployments to Iraq, in 2007 and 2009. He is a past commander of American Legion Post 574, and currently serves on the executive board of American Legion Post #79 and as 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Commander for District 21. He volunteers to help homeless veterans in the community.
