BACKGROUND:

1. Murrieta Community Pantry - \$5,000- The funding will be used to assist families with weekly food distribution for 500 families in the Winchester, Murrieta and French Valley areas. In addition, the pantry delivers weekly food to homebound senior citizens.
2. Hemet Community Pantry- \$7,000- Provides food for homebound seniors, veterans and disabled individuals who have no means of transportation or family members to pick up food from the facility in the Hemet / San Jacinto area and assist them with utility assistance.
3. Team Evangelical Assistance Ministries- \$5,000- The funding will be allocated for food purchase and supplies the pantry also provides some specialty holiday food items will be purchased for families.
4. Single Mothers United in Rewarding Fellowship, (SMURF) - \$4,000- The funding will be used to purchase gas cards for single mothers to find jobs, attend court dates and / or medical appointments.
