



BACKGROUND:

1. Boy Scouts of America, California Inland Empire Council - \$2,500- The funds will be utilized for the creation of new scouting units, and scholarships for camp.
2. City of San Jacinto- \$5,000 - The funding is for the sponsorship of the annual Independence Day Hometown Parade on July 4, 2015. The sponsorship will assist with the cost of law enforcement during the parade.
3. Voices for Children- \$10,000 - Provides Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) for foster children living in the Third District, and for recruitment, training, and management of volunteers living in the Third District.
