

BACKGROUND:

1. Rotary Club of Murrieta - \$5,000 – The funding will be used to sponsor the “Murrieta Field of Honor”. A patriotic week of activities to recognize and honor veterans from the Southwest areas. An estimated 10-15 thousand people will tour and experience the Field of Honor throughout the week.
2. Homes for our Troops - \$3,365 – The funding will be used for the goal of providing barrier-free homes in Southwest area for our nation’s most severely injured post 9/11 Veterans.
3. Friends of Valley-Wide Foundation - \$5,000 – The goal of the program is to provide scholarships to low to moderate income youth. The scholarships will provide access for children to participate in quality sports and recreation programs in the Hemet / San Jacinto areas.
