**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On November 4, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved the project budget in the amount of \$1,030,000 and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids for the SWJC Perimeter Fence project. On January 14, 2015, a mandatory job walk was held and a total of eight general contractors attended the job walk. On February 4, 2015, a bid opening was conducted and Hinkley and Associates, Inc. (Hinkley) was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

On February 10, 2015, the Economic Development Agency (EDA) received a letter from Hinkley requesting their bid proposal be withdrawn due to a clerical error. Riverside County Counsel reviewed Hinkley's request for bid withdrawal and determined that the request would meet the statutory criteria outlined in Public Contract Code § 5103 to satisfy the courts.

The second lowest responsive and responsible bid received was higher than the approved construction budget, EDA is therefore requesting that the Board formally reject all bids and allow EDA to seek an alternative means of delivering the project.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

Rejecting all bids and allowing EDA to seek an alternative means of delivering the project will provide a significant savings to the county.

**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 859.3  
AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE  
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 859 THE WATER EFFI-  
CIENT LANDSCAPE REQUIREMENTS**

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code section 25124(b). A certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 859.3 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California, 92501.

Ordinance No. 859.3 amends Ordinance No. 859 to include additional changes and restrictions related to water conservation measures. Key changes to the prior ordinance include the following: (1) prohibits the use of natural turf grass in front yards of new residential subdivisions; (2) requires new landscapes serviced by potable water to not exceed a maximum water demand of 50% of the evapotranspiration rate, which is a measure of the amount of water consumption used in a landscape through root absorption and/or evaporation; (3) requires new landscapes serviced entirely by recycled water to not exceed a maximum water demand of 70% of the evapotranspiration rate; and (4) prohibits the new installation of natural turf grass within medians and parkways within and along County of Riverside maintained roads. As an urgency ordinance, Ordinance No. 859.3 would become effective immediately after its adoption.
