BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside Educational Enrichment Foundation \$1,000 funding will be used to support both the Riverside Educational Enrichment Foundation (REEF) and Alvord Educational Foundation (AEF) on their mission to provide educational enrichment programs for 63,000 students.
- 2. Veterans of Foreign Wars Motorcycle Club, Empire Chapter \$1,000 funding will be used to support the Emergency Food Assistance Program that serves veterans, active military families, widows, and shut-in seniors within the First District.
- 3. Community Connect \$1,000 funding will be used to support the education and training of non-profits in Riverside County. Training will consist of leadership and professional development skills, grant writing, marketing, and workplace wellness.
- **4.** Operation SafeHouse \$2,500 funding will be used to assist foster youth and formerly homeless youth at the Main Street Transitional Living Program. The funding will be utilized to assist in the purchase of a/c units, refrigerators and to make building repairs.
