BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. **Western Science Center** - promotes appreciation and learning for people of all ages, of the natural history and cultural heritage of the region. The funding will be used for programing for the exhibit space at the Science Saturday free community event, and the simulated dig site.
2. **California Veterans for Foreign Wars Motorcycle Club** - will utilize the funding for the food box program that delivers food to the homes of veterans, families and seniors.
3. **Hospice of the Valleys** – provides help to terminally ill patients and their families in three communities in the Third District. The funding allocated will help with bereavement services that are not covered by Medicare or private insurance.
4. **Smiles for Seniors** - will provide to low-income seniors basic necessities such as food housing, utility assistance and minor home repairs.
5. **Boys and Girls Clubs of Southwest County**- will utilize the funding for the Triple Play Program that focuses on wellness of mind, body, and soul. Kids participate in outdoor activities and games that improve cardiovascular health. In addition, \$1,000 will be allocated for carpet repair at the Murrieta
6. **Friends of the Temecula Children's Museum** - the funding will provide themed programming every week of the year to further enhance the children's ability to discover science through STEM and STEM learning objectives.
