BACKGROUND: Summary

- The Riverside County Family Resource Center in Desert Hot Springs will host the Desert Hot Springs
 Family Resource Fair on November 4, 2015 at the Desert Hot Springs Wellness Center. The purpose of
 the resource fair is to provide information about available services to the residents of Desert Hot
 Springs and surrounding communities. CID funds will be used towards the costs of the facility,
 marketing and water for the event participants.
- 2. The Galilee Center provides food, clothing and services to help individuals and families in the eastern Coachella Valley who are underserved and disadvantaged. The goal of the Galilee Center is to help reduce the poverty level by providing comprehensive programs such as rental and utility assistance, school supplies and backpacks for students, food and clothing distribution. CID funds will be used to purchase food and offset the operating expenses of the food distribution program.
- 3. The LGBT Community Center of the Desert will hold the 6th Annual Center Stage Gala on October 30, 2015. This event will benefit the LGBT Community Center's programs such as the mental health clinic, community food bank and the health and wellness programs. CID funds will be used towards offsetting the cost of the event, such as the evening's entertainment.
- 4. The 30th Annual College Voc-Tech Night will take place at the Fullenwider Auditorium at the Riverside County Fairgrounds in Indio on October 14, 2015. This event is hosted by the following high schools: Amistad, Coachella Valley, Desert Mirage, Indio, La Familia and West Shores. More than 3,000 students and their parents are expected to attend and have the opportunity to meet with representatives from colleges, technical and vocational institutions, military branches and employers. CID funding will cover the cost of renting the Fullenwider Auditorium.
