BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. **Riverside County Deputy District Attorney Association** - seeks to build bridges with the community and lessen the economic gap by providing scholarships for foster kids, supporting anti-bullying workshops for local educators, and assisting bus passes for students who are unable to get to school.
2. **The Unforgettables Foundation** – the funds will be used to assist low-income families with a child's burial and support services for the family members.
3. **Art'N Kids** - provides children 5-18 structured art classes both after school and during the summer months to children from low-income families with the focus of improving the children's quality of life through art. The funding will be used for children to participate in the disciplines of art.
4. **The Manzantia Ranch** - the mission of the ranch is to use horses in therapy for veterans with PTSD and other disabilities. Horses have proven ability to create a healing bond with humans. The funding will be used for operations of the ranch, and to maintain the horses.
