BACKGROUND:

Summary

On June 23, 2015, the Mayor of San Jacinto approved the execution of the City's First Amendment to its law enforcement services agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. This amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the deletion of two School Resource Officer (SRO) positions. The two SRO positions will be redeployed for the same service on a new five year contract with the San Jacinto Unified School District.

Sheriff's staff has estimated a five percent annual increase to offset salary and benefit increases only. The Sheriff's Department is also recommending Board approval of the San Jacinto school district agreement that is also submitted for Board approval during this Agenda meeting. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

This is an amendment to the agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the San Jacinto City Council approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. In addition, the San Jacinto School District will redeploy the positions for the same service pursuant to a new five year agreement. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.

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FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND THE CITY OF SAN JACINTO

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and the City of San Jacinto, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on March 24, 2015, for services effective July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

Four (4) Community Service Officer II positions

One (1) Supervising Office Assistant II position

One (1) Office Assistant III position
