BACKGROUND: Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Perris Police Explorer's Post 522**—funds will be used towards their annual National Night Out and Shop with a Cop programs. These programs promote crime prevention awareness to the city neighborhoods and communities within the district and assistance to the underserved youth and families of the community.
2. **Foundation of Aging**—annual support funding will be used to provide food to needy seniors in the communities and help reduce senior hunger, isolation and depression during the holiday season.
3. **The Unforgettables Foundation.**—annual support funding will be towards providing burial/cremation assistance for children of low income families.
4. **Riverside County Regional Medical Center Foundation**—annual support funding will be used towards needed medical equipment for the Riverside County Regional Medical Center and support programs that benefit the patients.
