



**BACKGROUND:**  
**Summary (continued)**

1. The donation to the Inland Empire Water Keeper will be used to sponsor the 2015 Fall Fest which takes place at Martha McLean-Anza Narrows Park. It is a family friendly festival, with the purpose of educating families in the importance of both environmental and water stewardship and raise funds for Water Keeper's vital programs.
2. The donation to the Riverside Community College District Foundation will be used to the 2015 RCC Hall of Fame Awards which raises money to support the 17 RCC athletic programs.
3. The donation to the Riverside Arts Council will support the Long Nights of Art and Innovation where students can share their art and science projects, can partner with local STEM businesses, and supply our youth with new tools, ideas and learning paths.
4. The donation to Calicinto Ranch will be used to sponsor at-risk children whose parents are incarcerated to attend camp and participate in ranch programs year round.
