BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

This amendment will clearly define what is to be included under the definition of tobacco in the ordinance by clarifying some vague language.

The Department will work with County Counsel to prepare the amendment to Ordinance No. 838. In order to ensure the ability to regulate, the ordinance will be amended to define "tobacco product" as either products containing tobacco, products containing nicotine or products containing nicotine and tobacco.

Additionally, The Department of Environmental Health seeks to remove a section related to advertisement of tobacco related products.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The expected impact on citizens would be continued access to tobacco and/or nicotine based products while ensuring that the retailers comply with local licensing ordinances as well as state and federal laws and regulations that prohibit the selling of these products to minor aged children.
