

RECOMMENDED MOTION (continued):

3. If the owners or whoever has possession of the real property do not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent or receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property, when necessary under applicable law, may abate the excessive outside storage and accumulation of rubbish by removing and disposing of the same from the real property.
4. The reasonable costs of abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.
5. County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Fact and Conclusions that the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on the real property is declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541, and a public nuisance, and further, to prepare an Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

BACKGROUND:

1. An inspection was made on the subject property by Code Enforcement Officer Lane Padilla on January 13, 2015. The Inspection revealed excessive outside storage of materials and an accumulation of rubbish on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinances Nos. 348 and 541. The items included but were not limited to: scrap wood, metal, antique farming equipment, wood roofing beams, pipes, old machinery, and old gas tanks, of about 11,273 square feet.
2. There have been approximately five (5) subsequent follow up inspections, with the last inspection occurring on August 18, 2015. The property continues to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541.
3. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the notice requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the administrative abatement proceedings for the removal of the excessive outside storage and accumulated rubbish.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Failure to abate will have a negative impact on citizens or businesses due to health and safety hazards, nuisance, and potential impact on real estate values.

11 I, Lane e Padilla, declare that the facts set forth below are personally known to me except to
12 the extent that certain information is based on information and belief which I believe to be true, and if
13 called as a witness, I could and would competently testify thereof under oath:

14 1. I am currently employed by the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department as a
15 Code Enforcement Officer. My current official duties as a Code Enforcement Officer include inspecting
16 property for violations and enforcement of the provisions of Riverside County Ordinances.

17 2. On January 13, 2015, I conducted an inspection of the real property described as 24850
18 Juniper Springs Road, Homeland, Riverside County, California and further described as Assessor's
19 Parcel Number 455-230-031 (hereinafter described as "THE PROPERTY"). A true and correct copy of a
20 Thomas Brothers map page indicating the location of THE PROPERTY is attached hereto and
21 incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A."

22 3. A review of County records and documents disclosed that THE PROPERTY is owned by
23 Warren C. Vermillion and Jacolyn F. Vermillion (hereinafter referred to as "OWNERS"). A certified copy
24 of the County Equalized Assessment Roll for 2015-2016 tax year and a copy of the report generated
25 from the County Geographic Information System ("GIS") is attached hereto and incorporated herein by
26 reference as Exhibit "B." The property is an improved parcel approximately 10.60 acres in size and is
27 located within the R-A-5 (Residential Agricultural) zone classification. The zone allows for outside
28 storage of materials on improved parcels of one acre or more provided the amount is limited to two
hundred (200) square feet with a maximum height of three (3) feet. Accumulated rubbish in not
permitted on any property within the unincorporated areas of the County of Riverside.

1 4. Based on the Lot Book Reports from RZ Title Service dated March 6, 2015 and updated
2 on August 12, 2015, there appears to be no other parties that may potentially hold a legal interest in THE
3 PROPERTY. True and correct copies of the Lot Book Reports are attached hereto and incorporated
4 herein by reference as Exhibit "C."

5 5. On January 13, 2015, I arrived at THE PROPERTY to conduct an inspection. I observed
6 excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish on THE PROPERTY. The outside storage of materials
7 and accumulated rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to: scrap wood, metal, antique farming
8 equipment, wood roofing beams, pipes, old machinery and old gas tankers, of about 11,273 square feet.
9 This condition causes THE PROPERTY to constitute a public nuisance in violation of the provisions set
10 forth in Riverside County Ordinance ("RCO") Nos. 348 and 541.

11 6. On January 13, 2015, a Notice of Violation was posted on the PROPERTY.

12 7. On January 15, 2015, March 25, 2015 and July 22, 2015, Notices of Violation were mailed
13 to OWNERS by certified mail, return receipt requested and first class mail.

14 8. A site plan and photographs depicting the conditions of THE PROPERTY are attached
15 hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "D."

16 9. True and correct copies of each Notice issued in this matter and other supporting
17 documentation are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "E."

18 10. There have been approximately five (5) subsequent follow up inspections, with the last
19 inspection being August 18, 2015. Each inspection revealed the accumulated rubbish and excess
20 outside storage of materials remained on THE PROPERTY in violation of RCO Nos. 348 and 541.

21 11. Based upon my experience, knowledge and visual observations, it is my determination
22 that the conditions on THE PROPERTY are dangerous to the neighboring property owners and the
23 general public.

24 12. Furthermore, a recent inspection showed THE PROPERTY remained in violation of RCO
25 Nos. 348 and 541.

1 13. A Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings regarding was recorded in the Office
2 of the County Recorder, County of Riverside, State of California, on March 24, 2015, as Instrument
3 Number 2015-0117272 and on April 22, 2015, as Instrument Number 2015-0163423. True and correct
4 copies are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "F."

5 14. A "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing
6 notification of the Board of Supervisors' hearing as required by RCO No. 725 was mailed to OWNERS
7 by first class mail and was posted on THE PROPERTY. True and correct copies of the Notices, together
8 with the Proofs of Service, and the Affidavit of Posting of Notices are attached hereto and incorporated
9 herein by reference as Exhibit "G."

10 15. The removal of all accumulated rubbish and excess outside storage of materials in excess
11 of 200 square feet currently on THE PROPERTY is required to bring THE PROPERTY into compliance
12 with RCO Nos. 348 and 541, and the Health and Safety Code.

13 16. Accordingly, the following findings and conclusions are recommended:

14 (a) the excess outside storage of materials and accumulated rubbish on THE
15 PROPERTY to be deemed and declared a public nuisance; and

16 (b) the OWNERS, or whoever has possession or control of THE PROPERTY, be
17 required to remove all outside storage of materials in excess of 200 square feet and all accumulated
18 rubbish on THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with the provisions of RCO Nos. 348 and 541.

19 (c) that if the materials and rubbish are not removed and disposed of in strict
20 accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541,
21 within ninety (90) days of the date of the posting and mailing of the Board's Order to Abate Nuisance, the
22 outside storage of materials and accumulated rubbish may be abated and disposed of by representatives
23 of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department, a contractor, or the Sheriff's Department upon
24 receipt of owner's consent or a Court Order when necessary under applicable law.

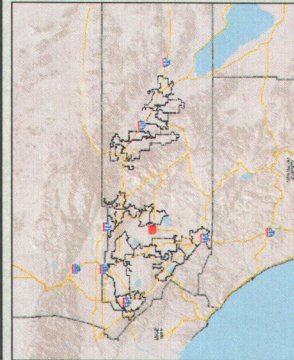
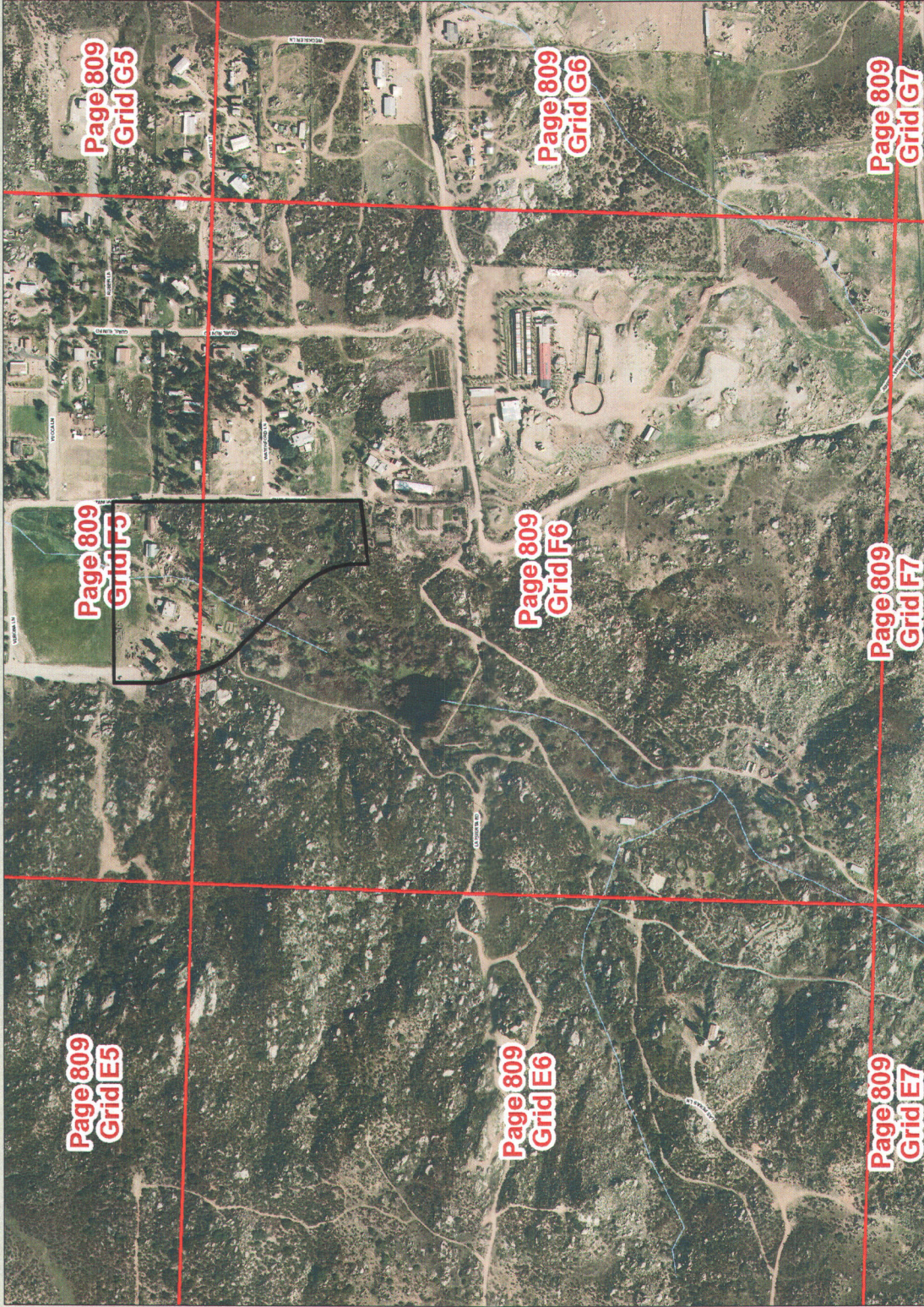

View Parcel Map





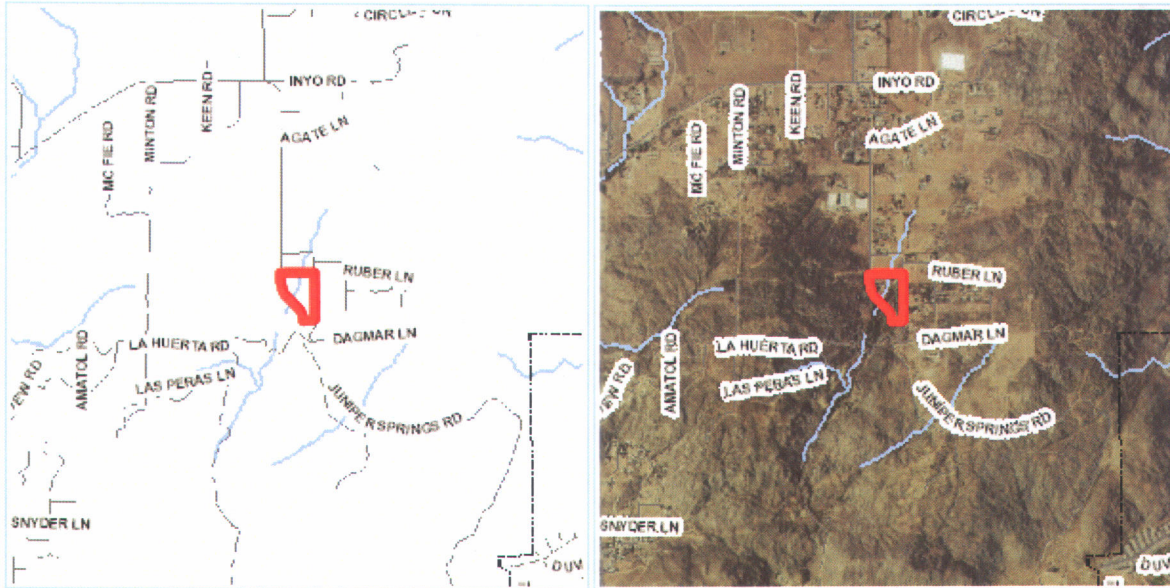

Said purpose for address must pertain to issues which are under the direct jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors. YOUR TIME WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES.

Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, insuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please insure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo.

Individual Speaker Limits:

Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes. Please step up to the podium when the Chairman calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. The Chairman adheres to a strict three (3) minutes per speaker. **Note: If you intend to give your time to a "Group/Organized Presentation", please state so clearly at the very bottom of the reverse side of this form.**

Group/Organized Presentations:

Group/organized presentations with more than one (1) speaker will be limited to nine (9) minutes at the Chairman's discretion. The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the front bottom of the form.

Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chairman:

The Chairman will determine what order the speakers will address the Board, and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles in order to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the general public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chairman may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.
