
RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. The donation to Brighton Hill Academy Sports and Learning Center will be used to start tutoring centers at 3 golf courses in the Second District.
2. The donation to Reach Out will be used to sponsor the Health Professions Conference in March 2016, which will host 500 students who will hear from area health professionals about their careers and the need to serve in the Inland Empire.
3. The donation to the Riverside Downtown Partnership will be used to market downtown Riverside as a regional destination by showcasing its retail businesses and restaurants.
4. The donation to the Fender Museum of the Arts Foundation will help them offer free and low-cost music lessons which will increase access to music education.
