
SUBJECT: Second District Use of Community Improvement Designation, (CID) Funds



BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. The donation to the Corona Senior Center will help sponsor the monthly "Corona Lunch & Learn" meetings at the Corona Senior Center which provides free meals and educational senior-related lectures, presented by professionals to seniors aged 50+ years of age.
2. The donation to the Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center will be used to help them continue to provide critical services, free of charge, during traumatic incidents. Community members are also able to participate in community education programs regarding prevention, awareness, and self-defense, all free of charge.
3. The donation to A Salute to Veterans Parade Committee will help sponsor the annual parade which has attendance of more than 5,000 people, and includes a pancake breakfast, meet and greet with veterans, and offers the community an opportunity to learn about our local heroes and view both historic and current military units and equipment.
4. The donation to the Rotary Club of Corona will help sponsor their annual fundraising dinner where funds are raised to support local programs, such as children at risk, hunger and literacy.
