BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

On December 8, 2015, by Minute Order 13-1C, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids for the Drilling, Construction and Connection of a New Water Well and Related Facilities At Mayflower Park, Blythe, California. The project will replace a failing water well and support system to provide a potable and dependable water source for the park. The project was advertised in the Palo Verde Valley Times and the ACR Reprographics "Plan Well Room." One addendum was issued to answer questions posed by potential bidders in accordance with County standard procedures.

A mandatory on-site pre-bid meeting was scheduled for January 6, 2016 with the bid opening scheduled January 14, 2016. Five potential contractors attended the pre-bid meeting. The attendees ranged from local (Blythe area) contractors to contractors from northern California. Three potential contractors submitted bids. AZCA Drilling and Pump Inc. (a Blythe area contractor) submitted the low bid in the amount of \$287,983.50 for the work outlined on the plans and in the specifications. The Parks Department has reviewed the bid and recommend that the Board award the Construction Contract to AZCA.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the Contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

County Counsel has reviewed the Construction Contract with exhibits and has approved them as to form.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The existing well has begun to fail and can no longer provide a dependable water supply to the park. The new system will replace the existing well and filter system. It will utilize existing storage facilities and plumbing. The project will provide potable and clear water to the park users as well as a sufficient water supply to meet the daily demands of the park and provide fire protection, providing a safer environment for park guests.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The Parks Department has already budgeted to utilize the existing fund balance in District CIP Fund 33100 to cover construction costs for the project.

CEQA Compliance

On December 8, 2015, by Minute Order 13-1C, the Board of Supervisors adopted a Notice of Exemption for this project. Nothing further is required because the award of this contract and the work to be completed is within the scope of what was analyzed in the previously adopted Notice of Exemption by this Board.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The construction award is for a total dollar amount of two hundred eighty-seven thousand, nine hundred, eighty-three and 50/100 cents (\$287,983.50), which includes a five percent project contingency. The engineer's estimate for the proposed work was approximately three hundred and fifty thousand dollars. The proposed bid was approximately seventeen percent (17%) below the engineer's estimate. The Parks Department believes this cost to be within industry standard and an acceptable cost for the proposed work.

Such person(s) or organization(s) is an additional insured only with respect to liability for "bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal and advertising injury" caused, in whole or in part, by:

- a. Your acts or omissions; or
- b. The acts or omissions of those acting on your behalf;

in the performance of:

- a. your ongoing operations for the additional insured; or
- b. "Your work" for the additional insured and included in the "products – completed operations hazard".

However, the insurance afforded to such additional insured described above:

- a. Only applies to the extent permitted by law; and
- b. Will not be broader than that which you are required by the contract or agreement to provide for such additional insured.

B. With respect to the insurance afforded to these additional insureds, the following additional exclusion applies:

This insurance does not apply to "bodily injury," "property damage" and "personal and advertising injury" arising out of the rendering of, or the failure to render, any professional architectural, engineering or surveying services including:

- a. The preparing, approving, or failing to prepare or approve maps, shop drawings, opinions, reports,

surveys, field orders, change orders or drawings and specifications; or

- b. Supervisory, inspection, architectural or engineering activities.

This Construction Contract is entered into at Riverside, California on

March 8, 2016, and is between the **County of Riverside on behalf of its Parks Department**, a political subdivision of the State of California, thereafter called "**COUNTY**" and **AZCA Drilling and Pump Inc.**, an Arizona, Corporation, hereinafter called "**CONTRACTOR**".

1. **CONTRACTOR** has submitted to **COUNTY** its bid for **the DRILLING CONSTRUCTION AND CONNECTION OF A NEW WATER WELL AND RELATED FACILITIES AT MAYFLOWER PARK, BLYTHE, CALIFORNIA**" hereafter called "Project," and all appurtenant work in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and **COUNTY** has accepted said bid.
2. **CONTRACTOR** has re-examined and carefully studied its bid and found it to be correct; ascertained that its subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces and will enter into agreements containing contractual terms identical to those of this Agreement; examined the site and fully understands all of the Contract Documents; and can do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the price set forth in its bid.
