BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

1. Western Center Community Foundation - \$5,000 the funding will be allocated to supply air-dried clay for the fossil replica station where every student gets to make and keep a fossil replica as well as other anatomy activities and to produce teaching kits to allow students to study fossil bison population from Diamond Valley Lake, giving them the math and observational skills needed to understand modern ecosystems.
2. Riverside County Regional Medical Center Foundation – \$300 the funding will sponsor the 2016 Spring Garden Tour with proceeds benefiting the Riverside University Health System's Medical Center's response to abuse and neglect of children and to heighten community awareness of the critical work this unit provides for children.
3. Salute to Veteran's Parade Committee - \$1,000 the allocated funding will sponsor the Salute to Veteran's Parade which recognizes all veterans and is supported by 1,000 volunteers. In addition, young people are paired with veterans to instill patriotic awareness and pride in our local veterans' contributions.
4. Musica - \$2,000 the funding will be utilized for bringing real instruction and developing great experience. The Bridge program works with San Jacinto Unified School District offering daily after school classes to beginning string music classes to students.
