BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The Board approved a contract with Granite Construction Company, in the amount of \$4,995,874 as Agenda Item Number 11-2 on October 21, 2014. The Board approved Change Order No. 1 (Agenda Item Number 11-2 on September 22, 2015) for paving rehabilitation requested by the City of Cathedral City and increased the contract by \$356,411 to be cost-shared between the District (\$72,376.95) and the City (\$284,034.70). Additionally, the total contract amount includes extra work resulting primarily from utility conflicts and City-requested items, as well as other miscellaneous items.

The total payment for this contract is \$5,713,957, which represents an increase of 5.92% over the Board authorized amount. The District does not anticipate any claims for additional compensation from the Contractor.

Financial Data notes:

- The "Current Fiscal Year:" and "Total Cost:" figures differ because construction began in Fiscal Year 14/15.
- The "COST" and "NET DISTRICT COST" figures differ by the aforementioned (\$284,034.70) City-funded betterment.

Final inspection of the above-referenced project was made, and the project was found to be complete according to plans and specifications. A brief project description and location map are attached.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The District constructed a segment of drainage infrastructure described in the District's Palm Springs Master Drainage Plan as Palm Springs MDP Line 43 and Lateral 43A. Construction of this project serves as the underground outlet to the District's Eagle Canyon Dam facility that was completed on September 21, 2015 with the Notice of Completion accepted by the Board as Agenda Item Number 11-1 on November 17, 2015. Completion of both District facilities will enable revisions to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps in the impacted area immediately downstream of Eagle Canyon Dam and will result in a significant reduction in flood insurance premiums.



PALM SPRINGS MDP LINE 43 AND LATERAL 43A STG 1 PROJECT NO. 6-0-00163



The project is located in Cathedral City. Once constructed, this project will convey flows from the District's Eagle Canyon Dam (currently under construction) to the District's existing North Cathedral Canyon Channel. This project includes the installation of approximately 2,400 lineal feet of pre—cast reinforced concrete box ranging in size from 5 foot wide by 4—foot high box to a 14—foot wide by 4.5—feet high box. The project also includes 1,800 lineal feet of reinforced concrete pipe ranging from 30—inches to 66—inches. The project also includes the relocation of two sewer lines and one waterline owned by the Desert Water Agency. The District will maintain the mainline, Cathedral City will maintain the catch basin and connector pipes.
