BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated January 12, 2016 (Agenda Item 3-15), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Van Buren Street Reconstruction and Sidewalk Project in the Coachella Valley, adjacent to the City of Indio.

The project consists of reconstruction of the existing pavement, road widening and constructing concrete curb, and gutter, on the east side of Van Buren Street. This segment of Van Buren Street, between 48th Avenue and Manila Avenue, is adjacent to Martin Van Buren Elementary School. Additionally, this project will construct approximately 800 linear feet of new sidewalk, including eight new access ramps and accessible driveways. Traffic improvements include removal of existing stripping and pavement markings, new signing, stripping, cross-walks, pavement markings and other work as may be required.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$469,520:

Base Bid Schedule:	Van Buren Street, street reconstruction and sidewalk improvements
Alternate Bid Schedule 1:	Carver Tract Mutual Water Corporation, facilities relocations
Alternate Bid Schedule 2:	Indio Water Authority, facilities relocations

The Reimbursement Agreements between the County of Riverside (County) and Carver Tract Mutual Water Corporation and Indio Water Authority to relocate water facilities within the project have been approved by Letter of Agreement, signed Carver Tract Mutual Water Corporation on April 1, 2015, and by Indio Water Authority on January 16, 2015.

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This project will improve pedestrian safety and provide an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant path for all pedestrians, especially students and parents traveling to and from the Martin Van Buren Elementary School.

Public outreach informing the area residents, businesses and school will occur prior to and throughout construction. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction. The construction duration set for this project is 40 working days, approximately two months, and construction is anticipated to be completed in the summer of 2016.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Granite Construction Company for the total amount of \$469,520. The project will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA funds and and partially funded with SB 821 Program through State Local Transportation Funds made available for use on bicycle and pedestrian facilities for which the County successfully competed. Additional funding by the Indio Water Authority and the Carver Tract Mutual Water Corporation will provide for the water facility relocations.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A contract for these improvements was originally awarded to Cooley Construction, Inc. on October 28, 2014, under Agenda Item 3-26. Due to unanticipated issues, the contract with Cooley Construction, Inc. was terminated, without prejudice, on January 12, 2016, under Agenda Item 3-16.

Five bids were received on February 3, 2016, ranging from \$469,520 to \$622,000 (including Base Bid Schedule and Alternate Bid Schedules 1 and 2). The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

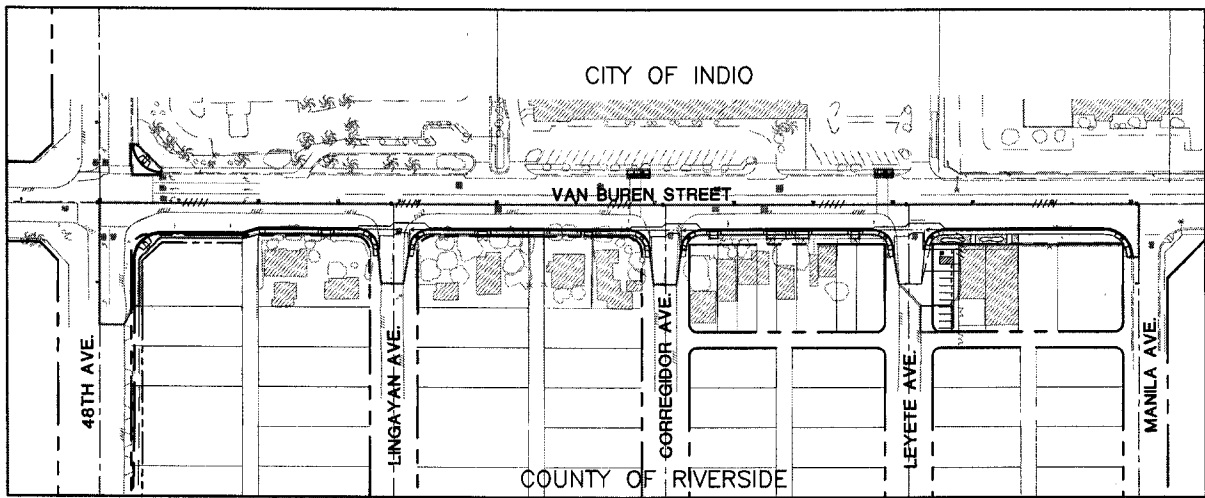
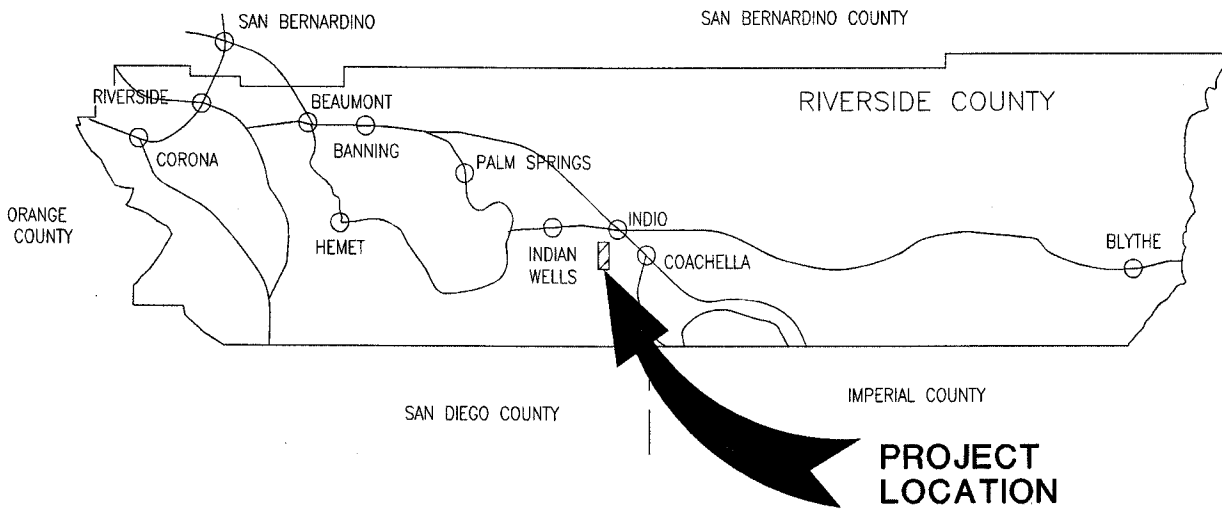
The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$469,520 which is \$10,480 (2%) lower than the Engineer's Estimate.
