**SUBJECT:** Approval of an increase to the Combined Agreement Aggregate Amount with the Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs) for FY 15/16. (District: All); [\$16,590,798 added for 4 years], Paid from Federal Funds 12%, State Funds 88%

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an increase to the Combined Agreement Aggregate amount with the SNFs from \$10,884,530 to \$12,311,097;
2. Exempt the County Purchasing Agent from the sole source requirement when adding new vendors not to exceed \$100,000 without securing competitive bids in accordance with Ordinance 459 while staying within the Board approved aggregate amount of \$12,311,097; and
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, based upon the availability of funding and as approved by County Counsel to: a) increase or decrease the Agreements listed in Attachment A; b) shift funds while staying within 10% contingency of the approved aggregate amount of \$12,311,097; c) sign renewals; and, d) sign amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the Agreements through June 30, 2019.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On June 30, 2015, Item 3-37, the Board of Supervisors approved the agreements with the Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs) in the aggregate amount of \$10,884,530 for FY 15/16.

Riverside University Health System – Behavioral Health (RUHS-BH) operates a continuum of care system, composed of County-operated and contract service providers, delivering twenty four (24) hour treatment in each geographic region of the County. The providers, listed in Attachment A, are all licensed by the State of California. The SNFs include a Special Treatment Program (STP) certified by the State Department of Health Care Services. In addition to providing medical services, these programs provide intensive psychiatric treatment for RUHS-BH clients at a level of care lower than that of State Hospitals or the county's Inpatient Treatment Facility (ITF).

Due to increased psychiatric services required and the need to accommodate increased demand for SNF services, funding for these contracts needs to be increased. Therefore, RUHS-BH is requesting that the Board of Supervisors approve the agreements with the vendors as listed in the updated Attachment A for \$12,311,097 for FY 15/16, authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign the updated Agreements as listed in Attachment A, increase or decrease these Agreements while staying within the newly approved aggregate amount of \$12,311,097, and to annually renew and sign amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the Agreements through June 30, 2019.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

These services are a component of the Department's system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The Agreements, outlined in Attachment A, are funded through realignment and include termination clauses, in the event applicable Federal, State and/or County funds become unavailable for the provision of services. There are sufficient funds in the department's FY 15/16 budget and no additional County funds are required.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

SNF rates were negotiated based on a combination of State established and County maximum allowable rates.
