**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The slurry seal treatment is provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The slurry seal treatment seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and help preserve underlying pavement structure. This project includes various roads located within the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial Districts. The specific roads are listed in "Attachment 1".

This project purposes Slurry Seal, Cape Seal, Microsurfacing/Scrub Seal surface treatments based on the existing pavement conditions.

The slurry seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregates, water, and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes road cleaning, crack repairs, application of slurry seal treatment, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times, at specified intervals, after the slurry has been applied.

The Cape Seal treatment adds a layer of "chips" or small crushed rock (screenings), and the slurry seal is placed over the chips and acts as a "wearing course" in areas of higher vehicles traffic.

The Scrub Seal treatment consist of an application of asphalt rejuvenating emulsion that is "scrubbed" into the pavement with brushes to force the emulsion into the small cracks and then the layer of "chips" or small crushed rock (screenings) is added. The slurry seal is then placed over the chips.

The Microsurfacing/Scrub Seal treatment uses a Microsurfacing Emulsion that does not rely on the sun or heat to cure and can be driven on in a much shorter time. The emulsion is "scrubbed" into the pavement with brushes but "chips" and slurry seal are not placed over the treatment.

To improve safety, a new centerline Rumble Strip on Reche Canyon Road, from Reche Vista Drive to the San Bernardino County line, approximately 3.5 miles, is included as an Alternate Bid Item. The Rumble Strip is evenly spaced ground-in indentations in the asphalt. The existing centerline striping and raised pavement markers will be removed and the road will be restriped and new raised pavement markers installed.

CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) describes the minor alteration of existing public facilities with negligible or no expansion of an existing use as a categorical exemption under CEQA; the project qualifies under this exemption since it is a maintenance activity taking place on existing County of Riverside (County) roads and there is no expansion of use.

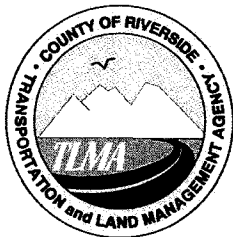

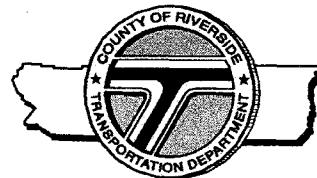

**PROJECT LOCATION:** Located in Unincorporated Riverside County, Various Locations

**SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT:** Districts 4 & 5

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (COUNTY) proposes to provide slurry seal treatment to existing pavement surfaces on various roads located in Supervisorial District's 4 and 5 of Riverside County. Slurry seal treatments are provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. Slurry seal treatments seal cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface, provide a new black pavement surface color, and help preserve the underlying pavement structure.

The Chip seal treatment adds a layer of "chips" or small crushed rock (screenings), and the slurry seal is placed over the chips and acts as a "wearing course" in areas of higher vehicles traffic.

The Scrub Seal treatment consist of an application of asphalt rejuvenating emulsion that is "scrubbed" into the pavement with brushes to force the emulsion into the small cracks and then the layer of "chips" or small crushed rock (screenings) is added. The slurry seal is then placed over the chips.

The Microsurfacing/Scrub Seal treatment uses a Microsurfacing Emulsion that does not rely on the sun or heat to cure and can be driven on in a much shorter time. The emulsion is "scrubbed" into the pavement with brushes but "chips" and slurry seal is not placed over the treatment.

The attached map and list identifies the roads for the slurry seal improvements. The list shows the roads by County Supervisorial District as well as the length, width and limits of the road improvements. These roads are located within the Western Riverside County MSHCP. Many roads, identified for improvements, are located outside Criteria Cells or Public/Quasi Public Lands. In this event, Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP states that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways outside Criteria Cells or Public/Quasi Public Lands are considered Covered Activities and are exempt from survey and mitigation requirements. The project does not involve the acquisition of additional right-of-way as all improvements will remain within the County's right-of-way.

For the slurry seal improvements within Criteria Cells or Public/Quasi Public Lands, Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP states that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered a covered activity, therefore, slurry seal improvements within Criteria Cells or Public/Quasi Public Lands are exempt from survey and mitigation requirements.

In addition, some of the attached lists of slurry seal improvements are located within the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (CVMSHCP). Under Section 7.1 of the CVMSHCP, all public facility construction and operation and maintenance activities outside conservation areas are covered activities and have been granted take authorization.
