This Addendum is issued pursuant to the Instructions to Bidders, Item No. 8, of the Contract Documents for the reference project. This Addendum is issued as a supplement to the specification and special provisions for the referenced project. The revisions to the specifications shall become a part of the Contract Documents, and each bidder shall acknowledge receipt thereof on the Bid (Proposal). Bidders are directed to sign this addendum as acknowledged, and attach the signed addendum to the contractor's submitted proposal.

MODIFICATIONS / CLARIFICATIONS TO SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

Item 1: Revised Proposal. Refer to "Proposal" pages B2-B4 and "Revised Proposal" Attachment "A" of Addendum No. 1. Delete and replace "Proposal" (pages B2 through B4) and "Revised Proposal" as issued by Addendum No. 1 with "Proposal (Revised)" attached herewith as **Attachment "A"**. The following changes have been made to the Proposal:

a. Estimated Quantities are revised for the following bid items:

- Item 32.C, "MINOR CONCRETE (MISCELLANEOUS CONSTRUCTION) [6" THICK V-GUTTER]"
- Item 47, "2" SERVICE CONNECTIONS (PER LHMWD STD. H-4)"
- Item 47.A, "1" SERVICE CONNECTIONS (PER LHMWD STD. H-5)"

b. The following bid items have been added:

- Item 32.D, "MINOR CONCRETE (UNDER SIDEWALK DRAIN CAST IN PLACE) (CRS 309)"
- Item 33.B, "ROCK SLOPE PROTECTION (No. 1, METHOD B) [6" ROCK]"

Item 2: Clarification, Pre-Watering Time. Refer to Section 19-10, Site Grading, and Section 00-1.03, Time of Completion, of the Special Provisions.

It is anticipated that grading will be performed during a dry period, pre-watering of the soil may be required prior to commencement of site grading.

Contractor may start pre-watering the site in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed". Access to the site will be coordinated during the preconstruction meeting.

The "Notice to Proceed" is anticipated to be issued no later than June 20, 2016.

Item 3: Addition of Reference Drawings. Refer to Appendix B, Reference Drawings, of the Special Provisions. The following reference drawings are added by **Attachment "B"** and made part hereby:

- County Std. 309 for Under Sidewalk Drain Cast in Place

MODIFICATIONS / CLARIFICATIONS TO THE PLANS

Item 4: Add Construction of Under Sidewalk Drain. Refer to plans sheet 3 of 11.

On Sheet 3 of 11, the following note is added at Station 17+05 (South Side of Mayberry Avenue):

Construct Under Sidewalk Drain per County Standard No. 309
1,798.51 TC
1,797.84 FL

Item 5: Revision of Service Connection Size at One Location. Refer to plans sheet 3 of 11.

On Sheet 3 of 11, Mayberry Avenue, at Station 15+64.93, delete the proposed 1" service connection and replace it with a 2" service connection.

Item 6: Grading General Notes. Refer to "Grading General Notes" on sheet 7 of 11 of the plans. Delete the Grading General Notes found on sheet 7 of 11 of the plans and replace them with the following Grading General Notes:

GRADING GENERAL NOTES

GENERAL

1. All grading shall conform to the 2013 California Building Code Chapter 17, 18 & Appendix-J as amended by Ordinance 457.
2. All property corners, grading boundaries and all Conservation Areas/Least Sensitive Area (LSA) determined by the Environmental Programs Department (EPD) shall be clearly delineated and staked in the field prior to commencement of any construction/grading.
3. All work under this permit shall be applicable to work within the property lines.
4. All grading shall be done under the supervision of a soils engineer in conformance with the recommendations of the preliminary soils investigation prepared by Inland Foundation Engineering, Inc. dated April 7, 2016.

5. Compacted fill to support any structures shall comply with Section 1803.5.8. Projects without a preliminary soils report shall include detailed specifications in accordance with Sections 1803.2 and 1803.5 prepared by the engineer of record.
6. The contractor shall notify Underground Service Alert, two days before digging at 1-800-422-4133.

CUT/FILL

7. Maximum cut and fill slope = 2:1 (horizontal to vertical).
8. No fill shall be placed on existing ground until the ground has been cleared of weeds, topsoil and other deleterious material. Fills should be placed in thin lifts (8-inch max or as recommended in the soils report), compacted and tested throughout the grading process until final grades are attained. All fills on slopes steeper than 5 to 1 (horizontal to vertical) and a height greater than 5 feet shall be keyed and benched into firm natural soil for full support. The bench under the toe must be 10 feet wide minimum.
9. The slope stability for cut and fill slopes over 30 feet in vertical height, or cut slopes steeper than 2:1 have been verified with a factor of safety of at least 1.5.
10. No rock or similar irreducible material with a maximum dimension greater than 12 inches shall be buried or placed in fills closer than 10 feet to the finished grade.

DRAINAGE, EROSION / DUST CONTROL

11. Drainage across property lines shall not exceed that which existed prior to grading. Excess or concentrated drainage shall be contained on site or directed to an approved drainage facility. Erosion of the ground in the area of discharge shall be prevented by installation of non-erosive down drains or other devices.
12. Provide a paved slope interceptor drain along the top of cut slopes where the drainage path is greater than 40 feet towards the cut slope.
13. Provide 5' wide by 1' high berm along the top of all fill slopes steeper than 3:1 (horizontal to vertical).
14. The ground surface immediately adjacent to the building foundation shall be sloped away from the building at a slope of not less than one unit vertical in 20 units horizontal (5-percent slope) for a minimum distance of 10 feet measured perpendicular to the face of the foundation.
15. No obstruction of natural water courses shall be permitted.
16. During rough grading operations and prior to construction of permanent drainage structures, temporary drainage control (Best Management Practices, BMPs) shall be in place to prevent ponding water and drainage to adjacent properties.
17. Dust control shall be controlled by watering or other approved methods.
18. Fugitive Dust control: Construction sites subject to PM10 Fugitive Dust Mitigation shall comply with AQMD Rule 403.1.
19. All existing drainage courses and storm drain facilities shall continue to function. Protective measures and temporary drainage provisions must be used to protect adjoining properties during grading operations.

NPDES: When one acre or more is being disturbed:

1. Construction site Best Management Practices (BMPs) for the management of storm water and non-stormwater discharges shall be installed per the grading plan. Arrangements shall be made by the contractor to retain the SWPPP on the jobsite throughout the time of construction. The implementation and maintenance of the site BMPs is required to minimize jobsite erosion and sedimentation. The contractor shall maintain those BMPs throughout the time of construction.
2. Erosion control BMPs shall be implemented and maintained to prevent and/or minimize the entrainment of soil in runoff from disturbed soil areas on construction sites.
3. Sediment control BMPs shall be implemented and maintained to prevent and/or minimize the transport of soil from the construction site.
4. The construction site shall be managed to minimize the exposure time of disturbed soil areas through phasing and scheduling of grading and the use of temporary and permanent soil stabilization.
5. Once disturbed, slopes (temporary or permanent) shall be stabilized if they will not be worked within 21 days. During storm season, all slopes shall be stabilized prior to predicted storm event. Construction sites shall be revegetated as early as feasible after soil disturbance.

6. Stockpiles of soil shall be properly contained to eliminate or reduce sediment transport from the site or streets, drainage facilities or adjacent properties via runoff, vehicle tracking, or wind.
7. Construction sites shall be maintained in such a condition that a storm does not carry wastes or pollutants off the site. Discharges other than stormwater (non-stormwater discharges) are prohibited, except as authorized by an individual NPDES permit, the statewide General Permit-Construction Activity. Potential pollutants include but are not limited to: solid or liquid chemical spills; wastes from paints, stains, sealants, solvents, detergents, glues, lime, pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, wood preservatives, and asbestos fibers, paint flakes or stucco fragments, fuels, oils, lubricants, and hydraulic, radiator or battery fluids, concrete and related cutting or curing residues; floatable wastes; wastes from engine/equipment steam cleaning or chemical degreasing; wastes from street cleaning; and super-chlorinated potable water from line flushing and testing. During construction, disposal of such materials should occur in a specified and controlled temporary area on-site physically separate from potential stormwater runoff, with ultimate disposal in accordance with local, state and federal requirements.
8. Runoff from equipment and vehicle washing shall be contained at construction site and must not be discharged to receiving waters or local storm drain system.
9. Appropriate BMPs for construction-related materials, wastes, spills or residues shall be implemented to eliminate or reduce transport from the site to streets, drainage facilities, or adjoining properties by wind or runoff.
10. All construction contractors and subcontractor personnel are to be trained in the implementation and use of the required BMPs and good housekeeping measures for the project site and any associated construction staging areas and all training documentation shall be maintained in the SWPPP.
11. Discharging contaminated groundwater produced by dewatering groundwater that has infiltrated into the construction site is prohibited. Discharging of contaminated soils via surface erosion is also prohibited. Discharging non-contaminated groundwater produced by dewatering activities may require a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit from the Regional Water Quality Control Board.
12. BMPs shall be maintained at all times. In addition, BMPs shall be inspected prior to predicted storm events and following storm events.
13. At the end of each day of construction activity, all construction debris and waste materials shall be collected and properly disposed of in trash or recycle bins.

Item 7: Add Installation of Rock Slope Protection. Refer to plans sheet 8 of 11 and sheet 9 of 11.

On Sheets 8 and 9 of 11, the following note is added at the 12" curb openings (refer to Construction Note 5), at the low point and at the outlet of the 3-6" HDPE (refer to Construction Note 25) in the infiltration basin:

Install Rock Slope Protection (RIP-RAP), 6' Rock, as Directed by the Engineer

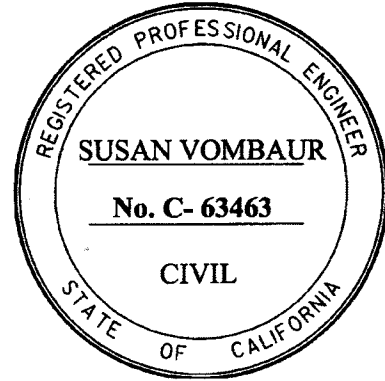
Item 8: Addition of Extra V-Gutter Construction. Refer to construction note No. 38 on plans sheet 8 of 11 and sheet 9 of 11.

Although shown as "Not in Contract" (N.I.C.) on the plans, 6" thick V-gutter corresponding to construction note No. 38 is now included in the project and made a part hereby.


Quantity for bid item No. 32.C, Minor Concrete (Miscellaneous Construction) [6" V-Gutter], has been modified to include this additional work.

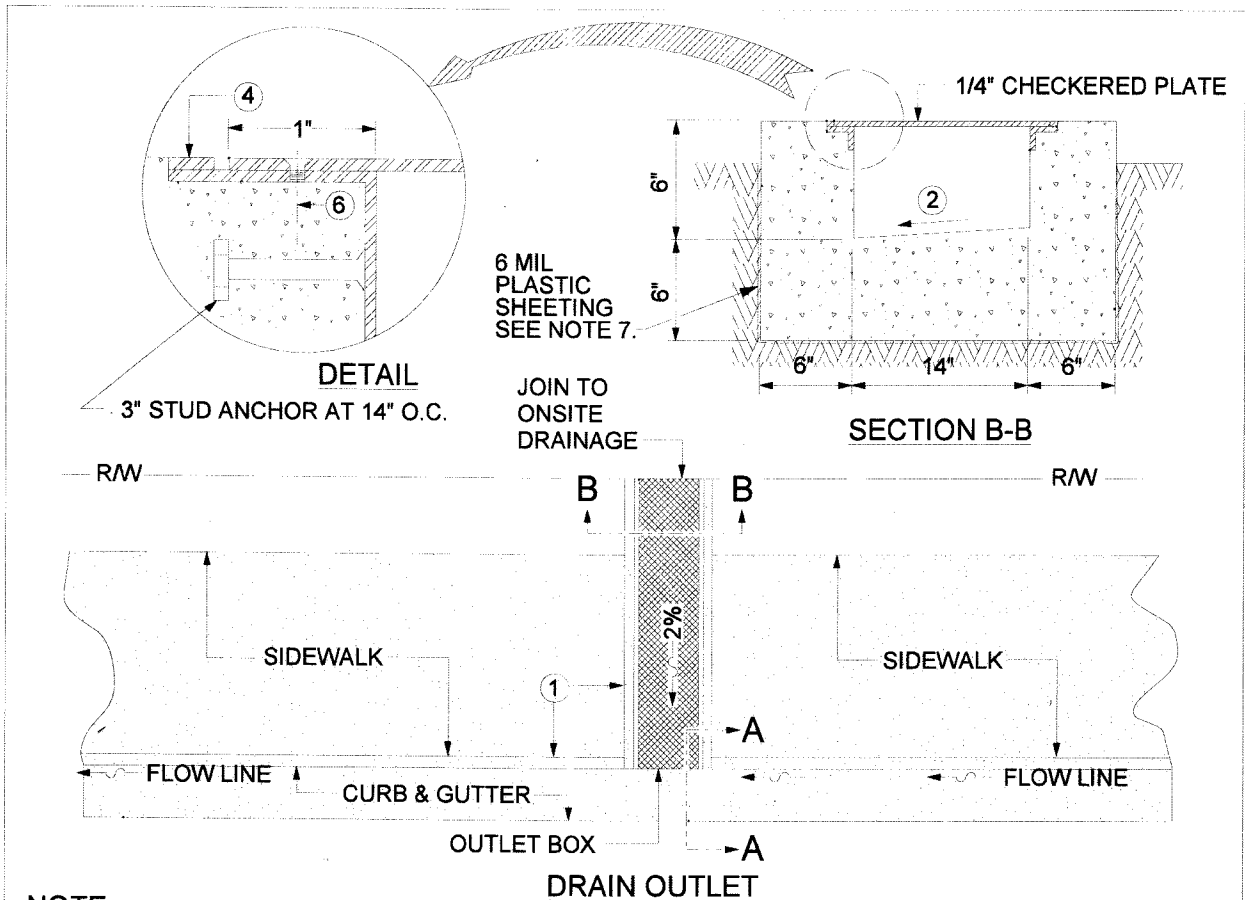

The undersigned, Contractor, having carefully examined the site and the Contract Documents for the construction of Exchange Club Park, Frontage Improvements Project, Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue, Community of Valle Vista, Project No. C6-0081 hereby proposes to construct the work in accordance with the Contract Documents, including Addenda Number(s) 1, 2 (Fill in addenda numbers if addenda have been issued.) for the amount stated in this Bid.

By submitting this Bid, Contractor agrees with County:

1. That unless withdrawn in person by Contractor or some person authorized in writing by Contractor (not by telephone or facsimile) before the time specified in the Notice Inviting Bids for the public opening of bids, this Bid constitutes an irrevocable offer for 90 calendar days after that date.
2. County has the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities contained in a Bid.
3.
