17 The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on May 24, 2016, before the Board
18 of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor Annex,
19 County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real property
20 described as 24431 Juniper Springs Road, Homeland, Riverside County, Assessor's Parcel Number
21 455-040-012 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY."

22 Sophia Choi, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Michelle Cervantes, Senior Code
23 Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Code Enforcement Department.

24 Owners did not appear.

25 The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer together
26 with attached Exhibits, evidencing the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of
27 rubbish on THE PROPERTY as violations of Riverside County Ordinance ("RCO") Nos. 348 and
28 541 and as a public nuisance.

1 **SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE**

2 1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder’s Office identify the owners
3 of THE PROPERTY as Marcos Ledesma and Ada Ledesma (“OWNERS”).

4 2. Documents of title indicate that other parties appear to potentially hold a legal interest
5 in THE PROPERTY, to wit: Verl L. Childers and Elizabeth M. Childers, Trustors and/or Trustees of
6 Verl Lee Childers and Elizabeth May Childers Family Trust dated May 20, 1993 (hereinafter referred
7 to as “INTERESTED PARTY”).

8 3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on April 9, 2015 and
9 on five (5) subsequent follow up inspections, with the last being May 18, 2016.

10 4. During each inspection an accumulation of rubbish and excess outside storage was
11 observed throughout THE PROPERTY consisting of but not limited to: tires, scrap metal, blocks,
12 pallets, scrap wood, mobile home stabilizing devices, building materials, mobile home parts,
13 appliances and other miscellaneous items, of about 10,000 square feet.

14 5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance
15 Nos. 348 and 541 by the Code Enforcement Officer.

16 6. On June 25, 2015, a Notice of Pendency of Administrative Proceedings was recorded
17 at the Riverside County Recorder’s Office as instrument number 2015-0272806.

18 7. On April 9, 2015, a Notice of Violation was posted on THE PROPERTY. On April
19 10, 2015, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNERS by first class mail.

20 8. On July 29, 2015, a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNERS and INTERESTED
21 PARTY by certified mail, return receipt requested.

22 9. A “Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance”
23 providing notice of the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors was mailed to OWNERS and
24 INTERESTED PARTY and was posted on THE PROPERTY.

25 **FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

26 WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in
27 regular session assembled on May 24, 2016, finds and concludes that:

28 1. WHEREAS, the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish

1 on the real property located at 24431 Juniper Springs Road, Homeland, Riverside County, California,
2 also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 455-040-012 violates RCO Nos. 348 and 541 and
3 constitutes a public nuisance.

4 2. WHEREAS, the OWNERS, occupants and any other person having possession or
5 control of THE PROPERTY shall abate the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of
6 materials by removing and disposing of all excessive outside storage on THE PROPERTY in excess
7 of two hundred (200) square feet with a maximum height of three (3) feet and all accumulated
8 rubbish in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO
9 Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days.

10 3. WHEREAS, the OWNERS AND INTERESTED PARTY ARE HEREBY
11 FURTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative
12 determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the
13 Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by California Code of
14 Civil Procedure Section 1094.6.

15 **ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE**

16 IT IS ORDERED that the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials
17 on THE PROPERTY be abated by OWNERS or anyone having possession or control of THE
18 PROPERTY by removing and disposing of all rubbish and excessive outside storage of materials
19 PROPERTY in excess of two hundred (200) square feet with a maximum height of three (3) feet on
20 THE PROPERTY in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not
21 limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541, within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order to
22 Abate Nuisance.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside
24 storage of materials are not removed and disposed of in strict accordance with all Riverside County
25 Ordinances, including but not limited to RCO Nos. 348 and 541 within ninety (90) days of the date
26 of this Order to Abate Nuisance, the accumulation of rubbish and excessive outside storage of
27 materials may be abated and disposed of by representatives of the Riverside County Code
28 Enforcement Department, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's

1 consent or a Court Order when necessary under applicable law.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable abatement costs, after notice and opportunity
3 for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special
4 assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code section 25845 and RCO Nos.
5 348, 541, and 725. Under RCO No. 725, "abatement costs" means "any costs or expenses
6 reasonably related to the abatement of conditions which violate County Land Use Ordinances, and
7 shall include, but not be limited to, enforcement, investigation, collection and administrative costs,
8 attorneys fees, and the costs associated with the removal or correction of the violation." Reasonable
9 abatement costs accrued by the Code Enforcement Department will be recoverable from OWNERS


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1 even if THE PROPERTY is brought into compliance within ninety (90) days of the date of this
2 Order to Abate Nuisance.

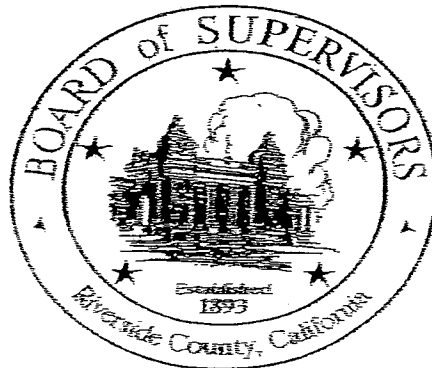
