BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The County requires an Electronic Patient Care Record (ePCR) to be in compliance with the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, §100147(e), which requires that the local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) agency has a system for prehospital data collection to evaluate emergency medical care.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no negative impact on residents or businesses in the County of Riverside. The extension of this agreement provides continued, uninterrupted service and quality control for emergency care in Riverside County.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Funding for this agreement comes from fees paid by EMS providers. No net county funds will be used.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Sansio, a subsidiary of Physio-Control, was awarded Prehospital Data Collection on Board Agenda Item 3.13, May 18, 2010 for five years, annually renewable. Board Agenda item 3.38, June 16, 2015, granted a one year, month-to-month extension to the contract to allow for transition from Sansio to a new system.

In 2015, Purchasing released a Request for Proposal #HSARC285 and five competitive responses were received for the ePCR system. ImageTrend was chosen as the most responsive, responsible bidder (agenda item 3.39, June 16, 2015). The development of the application and implementation of the ePCR system to all providers countywide is being done in test stages. The previously existing ePCR system needs to remain functional until the new system is ready to go live with all providers. This amendment asks for the extension of the contract with Sansio on a month-to-month basis until the ImageTrend ePCR system can be turned on for all providers. The target date to transition completely from Sansio to ImageTrend is January 2017.

Original Contract Term: May 18, 2010 through June 30, 2016
Effective Date of Amendment: July 1, 2016
Annual Maximum Contract Amount: \$131,370

The Agreement between Riverside County, herein referred to as COUNTY and SANSIO, herein referred to as CONTRACTOR, is amended as follows:

1. On page 3 of the Agreement, amend Section 2 the "Period of Performance": To amend all reference to the Period of Performance from expiration of June 30, 2016 to a Period of Performance through June 30, 2017 unless terminated as specified in Section 5 TERMINATION. All other terms of the Period of Performance in the Agreement shall apply.
2. On page 3 of the Agreement, amend Section 3 the "Compensation": The COUNTY agrees to pay CONTRACTOR for services performed at a monthly rate of Ten Thousand, Nine Hundred and Forty Seven dollars (\$10,947) to be paid in monthly installments including all expenses, based on the availability of fiscal funding.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement are to remain unchanged.
