BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Jurupa Unified School District requests to amend their Three-Year Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department. Effective the second contract year FY 2016-17; this Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement services provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of one (1) School Resource Officer. Under this agreement the Sheriff's Department will provide a total for seven (7) SROs. Four (4) SROs will be assigned to the Jurupa Valley High School, Patriot High School, Rubidoux High School, and Nueva Vista Continuation High School campuses. Three (3) SROs will be assigned to the Jurupa Middle School, Mira Lorna Middle School and Mission Middle School campuses. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.

The FY 2016-17 estimated law enforcement cost includes the additional SRO and a 5% rate increase; for a total of \$130,455. The Department has included the cost estimate in its budget request; therefore, no budget adjustment is necessary.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Sheriff and the District share common goals that include the provision of programs that address the needs of students at risk. The SRO's serve as a visual deterrent to aberrant behavior and thereby enhance the District's campus control and student protection. All costs will be fully recovered through Board approved contract rates.




